The TVS Auxiliary Programs team is eager to serve your PreK-8 child(ren) beyond the school day by providing a safe, healthy, and supportive environment in which they may complete homework, engage in indoor and outdoor free play, and participate in organized activities.

Extended Day at TVS is divided into three broad categories:

- ★ **TED (Trojan Extended Day)** >> Grades PreK-4
- ★ **TSS (Trojan Supervised Study)** >> Grades 5-8
- ★ **Additional Childcare** >> Grades PreK-8, irregular times such as half-days and Conference Days

We hope you find this guide helpful as you plan your family's schedule beyond the school day! *Information about our exciting Fall 2024 collection of after-school Enrichment programs will be released in July 2024; information about Spring 2025 Enrichment will be released in November 2024.*

Trinity Valley School Auxiliary Programs Vision Statement

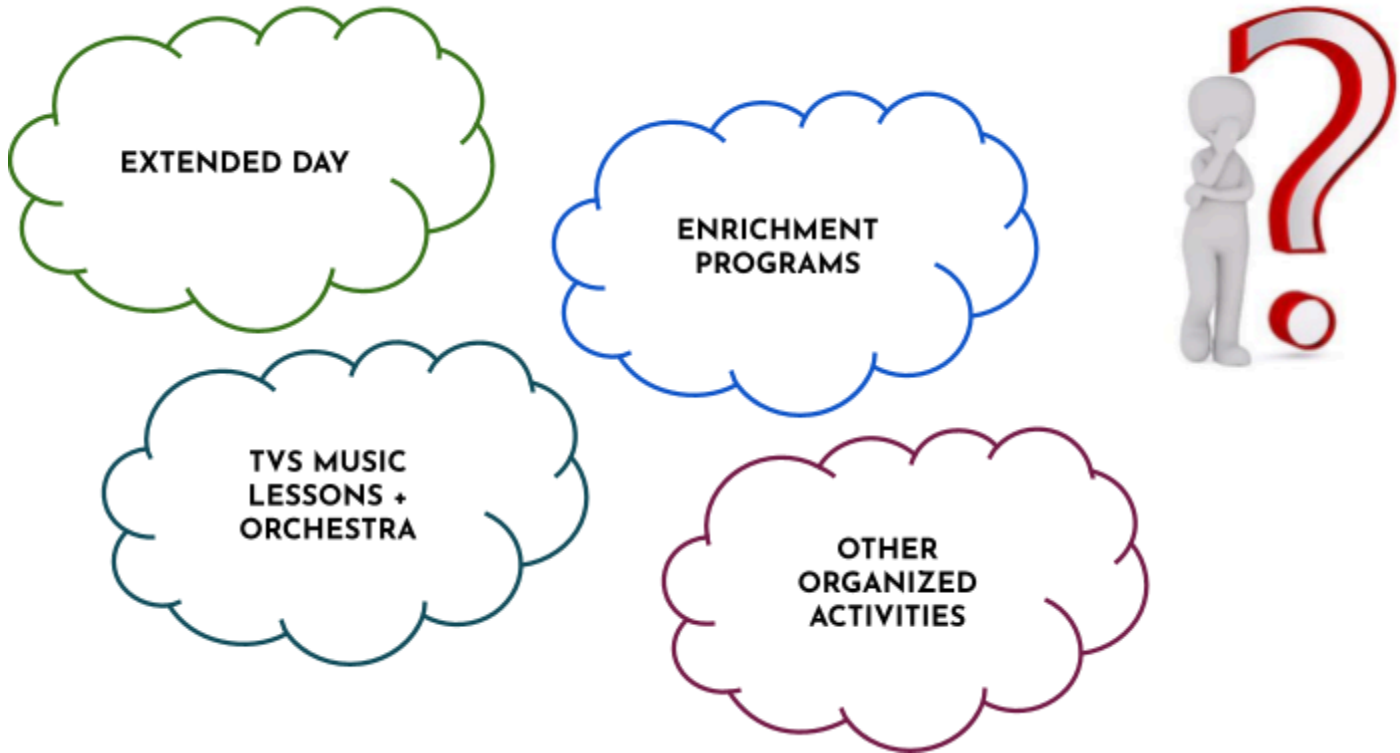
In keeping with the mission and philosophy of Trinity Valley School, our Auxiliary Programs exist to **develop our students' wide constructive interests** by **expanding and enriching their academic, creative, and athletic horizons**. TVS Auxiliary Programs aim to **develop upstanding and empathetic leaders** by **building authentic partnerships** with the Fort Worth community, **creating meaningful opportunities** for TVS faculty and students to learn and serve, and **co-constructing solutions** to needs in the community.

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- What are my after-school options? -

In order to help ensure the safety of each and every student, **we require that children in grades PreK-8 are supervised at all times while on campus**, including after the school day. Therefore, we offer families several options for after-school care:



Please note that the TVS Auxiliary Programs team manages **Extended Day** (this guide) and after-school **Enrichment** programming (information to be released in July for the fall semester and November for the spring semester).

Information about TVS Music lessons and orchestra may be obtained through Grace Moreno (morenog@tvs.org).

Information about other organized activities - which are typically sponsored by individual faculty - will be distributed throughout the school year.

Seventh and Eighth Grade students often participate in Athletics until around 4:00. This is considered part of their school day. After they are dismissed from Athletics, they may either get picked up, attend TSS (see pp. 6-7), or participate in an Enrichment program that begins after 4:00.

- TED (Trojan Extended Day): Grades PreK-4 -

Trojan Extended Day - also called "TED" - provides a safe, creative, and positive before- and after-school environment for TVS students in grades PreK-4. TED time prioritizes play (indoors and outdoors), but also includes homework and snack time. Cynthia Davis (daviscynthia@tvs.org), TED Coordinator, leads this team.

TED occurs Monday through Friday in the TVS Dining Hall. Any location changes will be communicated in advance.

- **Before Care runs from 7:00 to 8:00 a.m.**
- **PreK Hour runs from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m.**
- **After Care runs from 3:30 to 5:45 p.m.**

For the 2024-2025 academic year, TED will begin on Wednesday, August 21, which is the first day of school.

TED offers full-year packages (see details below), but drop-in attendance is certainly allowed. The full-year packages are discounted options, encouraged if you expect your child to attend every day or more than 75% of the time. Dropping in is more cost-effective if you anticipate using this service only occasionally.

7:00 - 8:00 A.M. - BEFORE CARE

Grades PreK-4 (with older students also present for breakfast)

- Before Care is completely free-of-charge!
- Before Care begins on Wednesday, August 21.
- Students will be accepted in the Dining Hall starting at 7:00 a.m., and will be allowed to transition to their classrooms starting at 7:50 a.m. **Lower School students on campus prior to 7:50 a.m. - who do not have a pre-arranged appointment with a teacher or staff member - need to be in the Dining Hall.**
- Before Care closes at 8:00 a.m. At that time, all students must transition to their classrooms.
- TED staff supervises the **entire** Dining Hall during this hour, including students in other divisions who may be enjoying breakfast with friends. Therefore - whereas we will place special focus on our Lower School students - our purview during this time is broader.

2:30 - 3:30 P.M. - PREK HOUR (starting Tuesday, September 3)

PreK Students (exclusively)

- PreK Hour begins on Tuesday, September 3. **For care prior to this date, please see the "Additional Childcare" section on pp. 8-9.**
- PreKindergarten dismisses at 2:30 each day, compared to 3:30 for all other grade levels.
- If childcare during this hour is needed - and you don't intend to enroll in our PreK-specific Enrichment programs - it is highly encouraged that you register for the full-year option so that your child has a consistent daily schedule from week to week.
 - Full-year fees are **\$950 / year**.
 - Drop-in fees are **\$3.00 / 15 minutes** (equivalent to \$12 / hour, but you only pay by the 15-minute interval).

- PreK teachers escort the children to / from the Dining Hall.

Grades PreK-4

- Families may register for a full-year package, or simply drop in after school.
 - Full-year fees are **\$2,750 / year**.
 - Drop-in fees are **\$3.00 / 15 minutes** (equivalent to \$12 / hour, but you only pay by the 15-minute interval).
 - Need help deciding? Check out our [Payment Helpful Hints!](#)
 - After Care begins on Wednesday, August 21.
 - Kindergarten teachers escort the children to the Dining Hall; Grades 1-4 students are directed to the Dining Hall, and are expected to arrive promptly. *Assistance will be provided to new students and those unfamiliar with the campus.*
 - Once the program ends at 5:45 p.m., a 15-minute grace period is allowed, during which time no late fee is applied. **After 6:00 p.m., a late fee of \$30 will apply, with no exceptions.**
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TED PAYMENT OPTIONS

Full-Year PreK Hour Package:

- This package includes after-school care at 2:30-3:30 p.m. on all regular school days, starting September 3, 2024, AND 12:00-5:00 p.m. on All School Half Days. Please note that this package does NOT include Conference Day Childcare or the PreK / Kindergarten-only half days at the beginning of the school year (**see the "Additional Childcare" section on pp. 8-9**).
- There are separate packages for PreK Hour and After Care. PreK families who typically need care well beyond the 3:30 p.m. K-4 dismissal will want to purchase both packages.
- Formal registration is required for full-year packages. This registration will open through the [Auxiliary Programs platform](#) in July 2024.
- There are two possible payment methods for this package. **At the time of registration**, you will elect one of these two options:
 - You may elect to prepay. The full charge will be billed to your FACTS account.
 - You may elect to pay in monthly installments. Your FACTS account must have auto-pay enabled to take advantage of this option.

Full-Year After Care Package:

- This package includes after-school care at 3:30-5:45 p.m. on all regular school days, starting August 21, 2024, AND 12:00-5:00 p.m. on All School Half Days. Please note that this package does NOT include Conference Day Childcare or the PreK / Kindergarten-only half days at the beginning of the school year (**see the "Additional Childcare" section on pp. 8-9**).
- Formal registration is required for full-year packages. This registration will open through the [Auxiliary Programs platform](#) in July 2024.
- There are two possible payment methods for this package. **At the time of registration**, you will elect one of these two options:
 - You may elect to prepay. The full charge will be billed to your FACTS account.
 - You may elect to pay in monthly installments. Your FACTS account must have auto-pay enabled to take advantage of this option.

Dropping In:

- Charges will be entered in the FACTS system, based on time of check-in and check-out.
- Charges will be applied in 15-minute increments.
- The drop-in option is TRULY that...there is no registration. Please simply notify your child's homeroom teacher on days when your child drops in, so that your child may either be escorted or directed to the Dining Hall.

NOTE: You must communicate with the business office before the start of the month to switch between a full-year package and the drop-in option.

- TSS (Trojan Supervised Study): Grades 5-8 -

Trojan Supervised Study - also called "TSS" - provides **TVS students in grades 5-8** with a safe, quiet, and structured environment to complete homework, study for assessments, and further develop organizational skills. Middle School teachers and Upper School student tutors provide both academic and organizational support with a low student-to-teacher ratio. Tina Clayton (claytont@tvs.org), TSS Coordinator, leads this team.

TSS occurs Monday through Friday in a set of Middle School classrooms. **Students report to Tina Clayton's classroom after school and remain there until they are picked up no later than 5:45.** If a pickup time by 5:45 is not possible, remaining students will join the TED grace period in the Dining Hall until 6:00. **After 6:00 p.m., a late fee of \$30 will apply, with no exceptions.**

For the 2024-2025 academic year, TSS will begin on Wednesday, August 21, which is the first day of school.

TSS offers a full-year package (see details below), but drop-in attendance is certainly allowed. The full-year package is a discounted option, encouraged if you expect your child to attend every day or more than 75% of the time. Dropping in is more cost-effective if you anticipate using this service only occasionally.

3:30 - 5:45 P.M. - TSS

Grades 5-8

- Families may register for a full-year package, or simply drop in after school.
 - Full-year fees are **\$2,200 / year.**
 - Drop-in fees are **\$3.00 / 15 minutes** (equivalent to \$12 / hour, but you only pay by the 15-minute interval).
 - *Need help deciding?* Check out our [Payment Helpful Hints!](#)
 - TSS begins on Wednesday, August 21.
 - Grades 5-6 students are directed to Tina Clayton's classroom, and are expected to arrive promptly. *Assistance will be provided to new students and those unfamiliar with the campus.*
 - Grades 7-8 students may transition to TSS after their athletic practice or other after-school activity ends. They are expected to arrive promptly afterward, and remain until they are picked up no later than 5:45.
 - If a pickup time by 5:45 is not possible, remaining students will join the TED grace period in the dining hall until 6:00. **After 6:00 p.m., a late fee of \$30 will apply, with no exceptions.**
 - TSS is closed on All School Half Days, but students are welcome to join Lower School students in the Dining Hall on these dates (**see the "Additional Childcare" section on pp. 8-9**).
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TSS PAYMENT OPTIONS

Full-Year TSS Package:

- This package includes after-school care at 3:30-5:45 p.m. on all regular school days, starting August 21, 2024, AND 12:00-5:00 p.m. on All School Half Days. Please note that this package does NOT include Conference Day Childcare (**see the "Additional Childcare" section on pp. 8-9**).
- Formal registration is required for full-year packages. This registration will open through the [Auxiliary Programs platform](#) in July 2024.
- There are two possible payment methods for this package. **At the time of registration**, you will elect one of these two options:
 - ◆ You may elect to prepay. The full charge will be billed to your FACTS account.
 - ◆ You may elect to pay in monthly installments. Your FACTS account must have auto-pay enabled to take advantage of this option.

Dropping In:

- Charges will be entered in the FACTS system, based on time of check-in and check-out.
- Charges will be applied in 15-minute increments.
- The drop-in option is TRULY that...there is no registration. Please simply notify your child and / or child's homeroom teacher on days when your child drops in.

NOTE: You must communicate with the business office before the start of the month to switch between a full-year package and the drop-in option.

- Additional Childcare: Grades PreK-8 -

There are certain times in the academic year when special schedules / events necessitate childcare. (This care will be provided by the TED team, but is sometimes billed separately from TED / TSS.)

Please note that we do not offer Additional Childcare on school holidays. *We appreciate your understanding, and we hope that this advanced notice allows you ample time to make alternate plans for your family.*

IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT ADDITIONAL CHILDCARE

A daily RSVP will be required for:

- the PreK / Kindergarten-only Half Days at the beginning of the school year, and
- the four Conference Days (two in October and two in March).

RSVP collection will occur at the beginning of each semester - alongside Extended Day and Enrichment registrations - through the [Auxiliary Programs platform](#).

Per Campus Security, we do NOT offer Additional Childcare on the half days that immediately precede a major break. As such, **families must ensure departure from campus at 12:00 p.m. on the following dates:**

- November 22, 2024 (right before Thanksgiving Break)
- December 20, 2024 (right before Winter Break)
- May 22, 2025 (right before Summer Break)

A NOTE TO MIDDLE SCHOOL FAMILIES

Dear Middle School Families,

We want to communicate just a couple additional items to you - regarding the Additional Childcare dates listed above - that will help your student feel prepared to participate.

*First, **TSS will be closed on All School Half Days.** Therefore, Middle School students are more than welcome to join Lower School students for the Additional Childcare on these half days if a noon dismissal is not possible! Please keep in mind that we'll close at 5:00 on these half days, which is earlier than normal TSS.*

*Second - to be completely transparent - Middle School participation in the All School Conference Days is historically quite low (only 1-2 students). Please understand that we are indeed staffed to accept Middle School students on these dates. However, **all activities, centers, etc. will be geared toward younger children.** To be mindful of your Middle School student's comfort, we request that you please consider only sending your student if no other childcare is possible. Please keep in mind that we'll close at 5:00 on these Conference Days, which is earlier than normal TSS.*
