

## Trinity Basin Preparatory

### 2024-2025 Student Dress Code Transition Plan for South, West, and Titan Academy

This Student Dress Code Transition Plan only applies to limited students at South, West, and Titan Academy. This document will only address allowable accommodations for students at South, West, and Titan Academy. **If an aspect of the dress code is not addressed, then students are expected to follow Trinity Basin Preparatory's Student Dress Code.**

The purpose of this plan is to accommodate students who attended High Point Academy through the 2022-2023 school year and still have pieces of that dress code that are clean, neat, and the right size which can still be worn. Any new uniform pieces that will be purchased, including to replace worn out or too small items, must fully comply with Trinity Basin Preparatory's Student Dress Code. This includes, but is not limited to, purchasing the jumper, skort, or skirt in the Trinity Basin Preparatory plaid; charcoal or navy pants; and shirts with the Trinity Basin Preparatory logo.

Only students in 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades are provided accommodations in this document. All Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students are expected to follow Trinity Basin Preparatory's Student Dress Code.

All 1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> grade students must follow Trinity Basin Preparatory Student Dress Code Professional Dress Uniform guidelines on Wednesdays.

Students in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades are not required to purchase a Professional Dress Uniform and may follow the Polo Uniform Day accommodations listed below.

#### DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS IN GRADES 1 through 12

##### **Skirt/Pants/Socks/Shoes for Polo Uniform Days only:**

- Red or blue HPA polo (logo required), short or long sleeve shirts; shirts must be tucked in at all times
- White Peter Pan collar shirt may only be worn under jumpers
- Official HPA crewneck or hooded sweatshirt (with official polo worn underneath)
- Plain front khaki pants; no skinny, cargo, or pleated pants
- Khaki jumper (logo required), skort, or skirt
- HPA plaid jumper, skort, or skirt
- Solid brown or black belt if there are belt loops
- Solid tan, white, black, or navy socks (applies to all socks, including "no-show")
- Solid white, navy or black leggings may only be worn under jumpers, skirts, and skorts in cold weather
- Skirts, skorts, and jumpers may be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- Solid white or black tennis shoes

#### DRESS CODE FOR BOYS

##### **Pants/Socks/Shoes for Polo Uniform Days only:**

- Red or blue HPA polo (logo required), short or long sleeve shirts; shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Official HPA crewneck or hooded sweatshirt (with official polo worn underneath)
- Plain front khaki pants; no skinny, cargo, or pleated pants
- Solid brown or black belt if there are belt loops
- Solid tan, white, black, or navy socks (applies to all socks, including "no-show")
- Solid white or black tennis shoes

On Spirit Days, students may wear an HPA t-shirt in place of a Titans t-shirt.

#### Outerwear

Non-HPA outerwear may be worn outside the buildings, but must be removed upon entering buildings. Students may only wear HPA outerwear inside the school buildings. HPA outerwear must be school approved and have the logo.
