DEADLINES: All homework, labs and classwork are due on the deadline given. Any assignment not handed in on the date given will receive a grade of "0". If you are absent it is your responsibility to find out what you missed. You have 1 week to make up the classwork, deadlines can be extended at the discretion of the teacher.
