## **Discipline Policy**

In order to maintain a classroom that allows all children to have a safe and caring environment in which to learn, we have developed the following classroom discipline plan. Please read through this policy and discuss it with your child, then sign the <u>We Have Seen</u> page and return it to school tomorrow.

## RULES:

- 1. Be IN YOUR SEAT WHEN THE BELL RINGS and STAY SEATED unless you have permission to do otherwise.
- 2. Come to class PREPARED with textbooks, notebooks, Chromebooks, pens/pencils, and completed homework.
- 3. LISTEN CAREFULLY and FOLLOW DIRECTIONS the first time they are given.
- 4. RAISE YOUR HAND for permission to speak or leave your seat.
- 5. Think about HOW YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE TREATED, and then ACT THAT WAY. Remember, keep your words kind and your hands, feet, and all other objects to yourself.

## POSITIVE OUTCOMES OF FOLLOWING THESE RULES:

- 1. Praise from your teachers and family.
- 2. Good grades for your hard work and effort.
- 3. Positive self-esteem and a sense of pride for a job well done.

## CONSEQUENCES FOR CHOOSING INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR:

1<sup>st</sup> time: A warning. The student may be required to stay after class to discuss the incident.

2<sup>nd</sup> time: 11<sup>th</sup> period detention to complete a Behavior Journal Sheet, which will be sent home for a parent's signature.

3<sup>rd</sup> time: Student will be sent to the main office to speak with the assistant principal or principal.

**Severe Disruption**: Student will immediately be sent to the office.
