

MAMMA MIA! Fun Facts

Mamma Mia! made its US premiere at the Orpheum Theatre in 2000.

Mamma Mia! is one of the few hit musicals that the roles of producer, director, and book writer were all women.

Though they had many No. 1 hits in Europe, Dancing Queen was the only ABBA song to hit number 1 on the US Charts.

Mamma Mia! is often credited with starting the trend of Juke Box Musicals. Jersey Boys, Rock of Ages, and Movin' Out are some that followed.

Mamma Mia! has been performed in 400 major cities worldwide.

Mamma Mia! has been performed in 14 languages. It is one of the longest musicals in Russia and was the first musical to be performed in Mandarin to tour China.

Mamma Mia! is the 9th longest running show on Broadway.

Benny Anderson and Björn Ulvaeus, the composers of Mamma Mia! and Abba members, also wrote the musical *Chess*.

The song Mamma Mia! only made it to number 32 on the Billboard 100 list.

The film adaptation of Mamma Mia! was the fifth highest grossing release in 2008, grossing more than \$608 million.


