"SENIOR PRIVILEGE AGREEMENT"

As members of the *Class of 2024*, you are individually and as a group, agreeing to the following:

- A. Seniors will enter into a contracted agreement with EHS for Senior Privileges for the dates: May 13th – May 31st
- B. Seniors may NOT take a "Senior Skip Day" --- either in small or large groups.
- C. Each senior will comply with the responsibilities listed below and **wear the Class of 2024 badge to enjoy privileges**. If the badge is lost there will be a \$3.00 replacement cost.
- D. Senior Privileges will be available only to seniors in “good standing” in terms of credits, fees, and fines paid, discipline, and attendance. Definitions of “good standing” are as follows:

<u>Credits:</u>	Students must be eligible to walk through graduation ceremony (at least 57 credits).
<u>Discipline:</u>	This is at the discretion of the administration.
<u>Attendance:</u>	All unexcused and unknown absences must be cleared up or consequence served.
<u>Fees & Fines:</u>	All fees and fines must be paid by <u>May 8th</u> . This includes the payment of the graduation fee.

Senior Privileges	Senior Responsibilities
Seniors <u>do not</u> report to class on June 3, 4 and 5.	There will be <u>no</u> "Senior Skip Day" -- the burden of proof for absent seniors will be on each individual.
Seniors in study halls will be allowed to go outside in designated areas <u>after</u> reporting for attendance.	Parking lots, playing fields, the pond, the wooded areas, and areas to the south of EHS or around DHMS <u>are off-limits and will not be included</u> in study hall privileges or lunch periods. Indoor play in hallways or study halls is not allowed. Furniture from the lunchroom is not allowed outside. Due to staffing issues, 5 th hour study hall will not be able to participate in this privilege. These students will need to remain in their assigned study hall.
Seniors are allowed to eat outside at lunchtime either on the upper or lower patio areas. They may enter the Commons through the east hallway <u>or</u> the west stairs.	Seniors will pick up all trash and dispose of it properly and will return all trays to the Commons. No grills will be allowed due to fire codes.
The Senior " <i>Class of 2024</i> " badge will be used as a hall pass with teacher authorization.	Seniors will have privileges revoked if they allow others to use their badge. *This DOES NOT include, passes to the library. All students MUST receive a school-issued pass to go to the library.

Items must be less than 4 feet long or 2 feet wide, non-motorized, and cannot be a person/guest. Any items deemed unreasonable will be held in the main office until the end of the day.</p>
<p>On Friday, May 17th and 24th during lunch, seniors will be able to participate in “Freezie Friday” (free freezies as supplies last). These will be handed out to those students participating in the outside lunch activities.</p>	<p>Seniors must have their badge present and must clean up after themselves.</p>
<p>Seniors will be allowed to have special meals delivered from local restaurants during their designated lunch period.</p> <p>May 14 – Raising Canes May 21 – Jersey Mikes</p>	<p>Seniors will need to order and pay by the deadline. All materials brought in for these events will need to be cleaned up by the seniors.</p> <p>* Students will eat their lunches during their assigned lunch periods. * No refunds will be given if you are not present on day of meal.</p>
