Dear HHS Senior Parents/Guardians,

As we navigate through the final marking period of the 2023-2024 school year, this is an exciting time for not only our students, but for their families as well. I would like to take this opportunity to share some key dates and information with you that pertain to the end of the school year.

Commencement is scheduled for Wednesday, May 29th, at 7:00pm at the Giant Center. We are honored once again to be holding this year's commencement ceremony at this impressive venue. Please see an attached sheet for additional information about commencement (tickets, parking, rehearsal, attire, etc.). Live streaming will be offered and the link to this live stream will be located on the school district's website on the day of the ceremony.

Beginning in early May of this year, school staff will be in touch with any students who have outstanding financial obligation(s). Outstanding obligations for seniors (i.e. textbooks, unpaid fees, lost items, etc.) must be satisfied by Wednesday, May 22, 2024. Students who do not satisfy these obligations will be prohibited from participating in the Commencement Ceremony.

Parents/Guardians of seniors may contact the food service office between May 21, 2024, and June 27, 2024, at 717-531-2217 regarding cafeteria accounts. Parents may request a transfer of funds to a siblings account or obtain a refund of any remaining account balance on your student's food service account.

Enclosed with this letter is information related to various senior activities. Please review this critical information with your senior and direct any questions to the senior class advisors, Mrs. Ogle (logle@hershey.k12.pa.us) or Mr. Mackneer (jmackneer@hershey.k12.pa.us). We recognize the importance of student voice and expression, however for this event, students are not permitted to decorate their cap for the ceremony. In the event that a student does, they may be asked not to participate in the ceremony.

Roses and Commemorative T-shirts will be available for purchase to benefit the Hershey Education Association's Scholarship Fund. The flowers and shirts can be purchased at the Giant Center on the evening of Commencement, or they can be pre-ordered online via the following website: www.thecommencementgroup.com/hersheyhs

Hershey High School Commencement Information Wednesday, May 29, 2024 – 7:00 p.m.

Program

The commencement program begins promptly at 7:00 p.m. at the Giant Center. Because of expected traffic congestion, you should plan to arrive by 6:30 p.m. Please note the doors of the Giant Center will open at 5:30 p.m.

Traffic and Parking

Please follow directions at the Giant Center for parking. Handicap parking is also available. When you enter, please mention that you are attending HHS Commencement and you will not be required to pay a parking fee.

Entrance to the Giant Center

All attendees must have a ticket to enter the Giant Center for the commencement program. There is no admission without a ticket. Doors open at 5:30 p.m. Each graduate will have been given ten (10) tickets during rehearsal earlier in the day. Seniors must report by 6:00 p.m. to the Giant Center, and all parents and visitors are asked to be seated by 6:50 p.m. We suggest pictures are taken before Commencement.

Everyone in attendance will go through Security (metal detectors will be in use and bags will be searched). Hershey Park Entertainment Complex and the Giant Center prohibits large bags inside its venues in accordance with event guidelines and security best practices. This includes backpacks, large purses, clear bags, fanny packs, camera bags, drawstring bags, totes and suitcases. Weapons of any kind are prohibited. Balloons are not permitted.

Hand clutches, wristlets and small purses are permitted but are subject to search and must not exceed 5" x 8" x 1".

Exceptions for bags are as follows: A medical equipment bag and/or a parenting needs bag smaller than 14" x 14" x 6" and all exceptions must go through metal detection screening at entry and are subject to physical search.

For Students

Students are required to report to the Giant Center by 6:00 p.m.

All students must wear appropriate dress and footwear (including their school-issued cap and gown) in order to participate in the program. For boys, this includes a collared dress shirt and necktie, dress slacks, and shoes (no sneakers or sandals). Girls are required to wear a dress, skirt, or pants suit with appropriate shoes (no flip flops). For this event, students are not permitted to decorate their cap for the ceremony. Those choosing not to wear appropriate attire (as described here) will not be permitted to participate in the commencement program.

Finally, seniors are to report to the Giant Center for Commencement Practice on Wednesday (5/29/24) at 9:00 a.m. Dismissal for students occurs upon the conclusion of practice at the Giant Center (at approximately 11:30 a.m.). Students must be prompt and attend the practice session in order to participate in the program that evening. Students and family members will enter ONLY at the turnstile gate entrance (upper parking lot area) as the Conservatory building and main entrance will be closed for the evening.


Please handle all corsage and boutonnieres before entering the Gardens to alleviate trash concerns.
