Dear Colleagues, good afternoon:

I would like to share an update about two professional development opportunities available to Virginia educators through Radford University's Vinod Chachra IMAPCT Lab.

1. We still have spaces available in the Program for Advancing Cybersecurity in Rural Virginia (PACE), funded by the US DOE. This program provides an opportunity for educators (teachers, counsellors, administrators) from rural districts to expand their knowledge about cybersecurity and careers in this high demand field. This program is offered at no cost to eligible participants. We would love for your educators to participate in the PACE grant program! There are a couple of options available to you through the PACE grant.

The table below outlines the three levels of training available and recommended participants (all training is covered 100% by the PACE grant):

Training	Recommended Participants
Full certificate program in Cybersecurity, GIS, or Data Science (Up to 18 undergraduate credits, no transcript required) \$6,498 value	Teachers who teach/will be teaching intermediate to advanced courses.
Foundations of Cybersecurity course (3 undergraduate credits, no transcript required) \$1,083 value	Teachers who teach introductory to intermediate courses, Instructional Technology Resource Teachers (ITRTs), and/or administrators involved in program oversight or design.
Foundations of Cybersecurity micro- credential (10 PD hours/points toward relicensure, 0.2 graduate credits; approximately 10 hours to complete online, submission of transcript required) \$72.20 value	Teachers, administrators, and staff who need some basic knowledge related to cybersecurity concepts.

All the content above is available at no cost under the PACE grant. The program is **100% online and self-paced, with 12** full months to complete...so that you can work on it at times that best suit your schedule. All content is online, so there are no books or materials to purchase.

Please let me know what level of training you are interested in, and we will email you the appropriate enrollment link.

2. Provisional to Professional Pathway program (flyer is attached) is open to teachers in school districts across Virginia. This opportunity may be of interest to your district, especially in the areas with teacher shortage.
