### TRANSIT AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Fulfill the promises of WSDOT's Move Ahead WA Package.

**Obligate the \$5 million in previously appropriated Eastrail funds in the next biennium so federal funds are not put at risk.**

### PUBLIC SAFETY

Support resources for law enforcement recruitment and retention. Provide adequate resources, such as continued funding for the City's successful CORE Connect program, to help address behavioral health needs.

### ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP
