Credit Recovery: June 3rd-June 27th

LDHS Summer School will be on the **LD MIDDLE SCHOOL campus each day from 8:15am to 12:15pm (Monday-Thursday).**

The purpose of Lake Dallas High School Summer School is 1) to provide opportunities for students currently in grades 9-11 to regain credits towards graduation and 2) to comply with HB 1416 which requires accelerated instruction for students that did not perform satisfactorily on their End of Course Exams.

Fees

Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration.

HB 1416 STAAR/EOC Remediation: No fees required
Credit Recovery Courses (student has taken the course)

\$100 for ½ credit / \$150 for full credit.

Acceleration Courses (student has not taken the course).
\$150 for ½ credit (Must have administrator approval).

Scholarships

Available for students who qualify for free/ reduced lunch status during the 2023-2024 school year. \$60 for ½ credit / \$100 for full credit.

Acceleration courses do not qualify for a scholarship.

Refunds

Refunds will be available prior to 1st day of class

No refunds after class starts.



Registration

Credit Recovery Courses Offered

Students will enroll in a single Edgenuity course and remain in that course until it's complete. They can enroll in additional courses if time permits.

- English 1,2,3
- Algebra 1,2, Geometry, Algebraic Reasoning
- Integrated Physics & Chemistry
- Biology, Chemistry, Physics
- World Geography, World History, U.S. History
- Health, Speech, Art 1
- Electives & Foreign Language (as available)

* Check with counselor for other available courses

Attendance

Students will be expected to be seated and ready to work promptly at the beginning of class. If a student does not attend the summer school each day or is not working towards completing the registered course, he/she will be dropped from the program without any refund. Students must make arrangements with the principal for any absence.

Transportation will be provided if you reside outside of the two mile limit from the school.
