

## **Works of Art**

The Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction allocates one-half of one percent of any moneys appropriated for state assistance to districts for original construction of any school facility for the acquisition of works of art. The district has the right to waive its use of the appropriation; such money will then be used by the Washington State Arts' Commission for the purchase of other public art. The selection and commissioning of an artist for reviewing of the design, execution and placement of the art, and the acceptance of works of art will be the responsibility of the Washington State Arts' Commission in consultation with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction and the superintendent. The superintendent will be a part of the selection process with the authority to reject the results and/or placement of a completed work of art. Waiver or rejection will not affect state construction funds available to local school districts.
