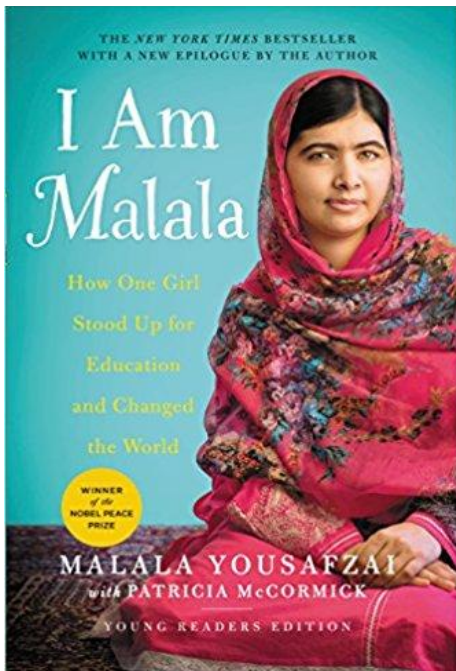


# Trinity Valley School

## Book Report Guidelines

Your paper must be typed and double-spaced using 14 pt. Times New Roman font. Please remember that a book's title must be in italics. Book reports are due on the Monday of the first full week of school.

- First Paragraph - The first paragraph of your report should include the title of your book, the author, and five to six well-developed sentences that **summarize** the entire book – an overview.
- Second Paragraph - An author creates a character by giving him/her certain attributes or qualities. The reader gets to know the "personality" of each character (player) through physical description, the actions of the character(s), and what they say within the story. In a five to six sentence paragraph, describe important personality qualities of one of the main characters. What do these qualities tell you about the main character? If the character changes in the story, describe how and why he/she changed.
- Third Paragraph - A good story always has a strong plot or series of related events that develop from conflict(s). Through the use of specific details, write a five to six sentence paragraph explaining the most important or interesting event in the book. What is the conflict or problems the characters face?
- Final Paragraph - In a five to six sentence paragraph, share your thoughts on this book. Support your opinion with specific references to the story.
