## Principal Report

- Facility Update
  - o Mr. Henry walked through facilities and requested all coffee makers and microwaves be relocated to the appropriate locations for teachers/staff. This is being completed.
  - o Davis has requested awnings to the portables, paved side parking lot, larger cafeteria
    - Davis has been notified that awnings will be installed over the summer
- Personnel Update
  - At this point four teachers/staff are not returning. One special education teacher, one second grade teacher is changing professions, one fourth grade teacher leaving, guidance counselor retiring. Davis has been able to fill each of these positions
- Calendar of Events
  - Very busy season. In the middle of grades 3, 4, 5, testing state practice test. Teachers can use information from this to prepare for actual state testing

  - o Fireflies games celebrating literacy on April 9th and 10th
  - Very excited about partnership with USC athletes for the student portfolio reviews
