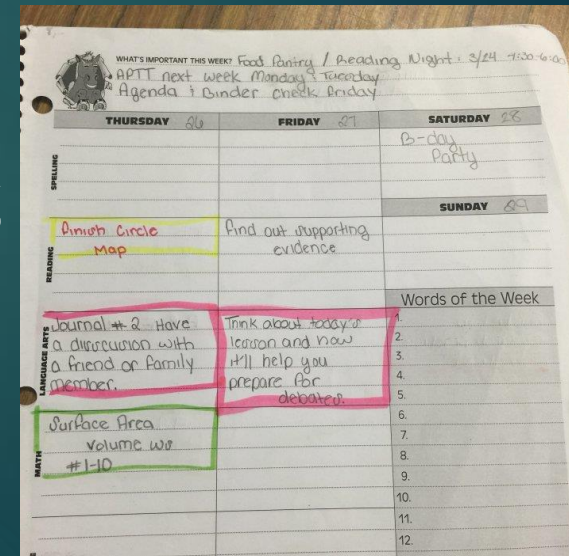
Organizational Tools
