

Commercial Audition Vocabulary-

Acting for the Camera

- 1. Casting Agent-** the person who makes the decision if you are right for the part in the commercial.

2. Gallery- the place where the people who want to audition wait to be called into the audition.

3. Actor's Resume'- an organized document that shows your accomplishments, attributes, and skills.

4. Side-a copy of the script that you will use to audition for the commercial.

5. Individual Slate-to state your name for the audition

6. Group slate-the group of actors auditioning will state their name one right after the other.

7. Sign-In Sheet-the place you write your name when you arrive at the audition. If you don't sign-in, you don't audition.
