**Enrollment Update** 

Dr. Brabham thanked the Board for their continued support of ROMC and having the wisdom and foresight to apply for the PPE funding back in the April. This was made in the anticipation that enrollment would be affected. Enrollment was effected by 15 students less than the budgeted number of students. Dr. Brabham informed the Board that we received 50-60 applications; however, due to uncertainty the accompanied the COVID-19 pandemic, numerous students decided to pursue other educational opportunities.

Dr. Brabham shared that she has been working with Denise from Prestige on different scenarios we decided not to hire the Student Activities Coordinator which will save us about \$96,000 (including fringe).
