School's Goals:

ILT YEARLY GOAL: By the end of the 23-24 school year, the ILT will examine and analyze teacher and student work/data to improve student outcomes in all areas.

BUBBLE STUDENT GOAL: By the end of the 23-24 school year, 100% of basic bubble students will score mastery or above on the LEAP 2025 assessment.

MASTERY PLUS: By the end of the 23-24 school year, the percentage of students scoring Mastery plus on the LEAP 2025 assessment will increase from 20% to 26%.

ELPT GOAL: By the end of the 23-24 school year, our ELPT AI will increase from 73.1 points to 80 points.

LEAP CONNECT GOAL: By the end of the 23-24 school year, our LEAP Connect AI will increase from 86.9 points to 90.0 points.

DISCIPLINE/BEHAVIOR GOAL: By the end of the 23-24 school year, we will decrease the percentage of students receiving referrals from 29.36% to 15%.

ATTENDANCE GOAL: By the end of the 23-24 school year, we will increase daily student attendance rate from 94.08% to 96%.
