Connecting Windows 10 to Home Internet Service

PURPOSE - This document will provide steps to connect a Windows 10 computer to an established home Internet (Wi-Fi) service.

1. Turn on the JPS Windows 10 Laptop. When the login screen appears, click CTRL-ALT-DEL.

4. After a successful login, go to the bottom right of the screen and click on the wireless symbol.



5. When the network popup appears, choose your wireless network (in this example *Tsunami-22*) from the list and click on the **Connect** button.
