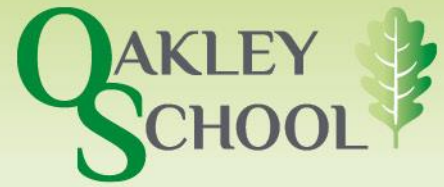

Dear Parent/Carer,

Oversley Hill Farm Trip – Tuesday 9th July 2024

I am delighted to offer your child the opportunity to visit a farm to learn more about the Food Provenance topic of where our food comes from. An aspect of the Food and Nutrition lessons at Oakley is to learn about this. The trip is to Oversley Hill Farm in Alcester, Warwickshire.

The visit will include a tractor and trailer ride to see the cattle, a walk to see the sheep and crops growing in the field. Throughout the visit the leaders will talk about the products we grow and produce on our farm. They have a suckler herd which goes on for beef production at a local farm shop which the students can see in the fields on the tractor and trailer ride. They have sheep which produce lamb. They grow, wheat for milling for cakes & biscuits, and other crops such as peas and beans grown for human and animal consumption. There is also an opportunity to see some bread and butter production.

There are **60 places available** for the half day trip. The cost of the trip is to cover transport costs. This will be **£6 per student**.

There will be two groups –

Group 1 will leave Oakley at 9:15am and return by 1pm.

Group 2 will leave Oakley at 11:15am and return by 3pm.

It will be made clear to your child which group they will be in, what they need to bring and if they have any specific dietary needs that will need discussing.

Please make a payment by Friday May 10th (payable via MyChildAtSchool). In the event the trip is oversubscribed we will select students at random. If you would like to use your Pupil Premium allowance, please contact the office (oakleyschool@stowevalley.com).
