# 10TH PERIOD POLICY

Students are required to stay for 10th Period for the following reasons:

- Missed the day's HW
- Missed class for music lessons
- Make up work due to absence
- Work with Peer Tutor
- Teacher directive for student to stay
- Specific questions regarding subject content
- Missed class for a Pupil Personnel Service (PPS) pass

10th Period is NOT a time for socializing with friends. Students may go to ANY class on their schedule. If a student does not need to stay 10th period for any of the above reasons, he or she may go home.
