What's different in 7th grade?

- ★ Only two teams
- ★ No core class
- ★ Only one English period, not two
- ★ Lunch is after 4th period
- ★ New classes
- ★ Accelerated math class is available
- ★ Increased independence & responsibility
- ★ Trip to Boston in April or May
- ★ Sports teams

7th Grade Courses

★ Required Courses- every 7th grader gets these classes automatically:

- English 7
- Science 7
- Social Studies 7
- Math 7 or Math 7 Compacted
- Music (Band, Orchestra, Chorus or General Music)
- Health (A or B day - full year)
- Physical Education (A or B day - full year)
- Foreign Language (Spanish or French) (A or B day - full year)
- Technology 7 (A or B day - full year)
- Home & Careers 7 (A or B day - $\frac{1}{2}$ year)
- Art 7 (A or B day - $\frac{1}{2}$ year)

★ If there is room in your schedule, you may also have:

- Astronomy (A or B day - $\frac{1}{2}$ year)
- Computers 7 (A or B day - $\frac{1}{2}$ year)

Math 7 Compacted

★ Requirements

- Overall Math 6 average of 88 or above
- Teacher Recommendation

★ Description

- The pace of this course is much faster than Math 7 because it also contains material from Math 8. Students who do well in Math 7 Compacted *might* be eligible to enroll in Regents Algebra in 8th grade.
