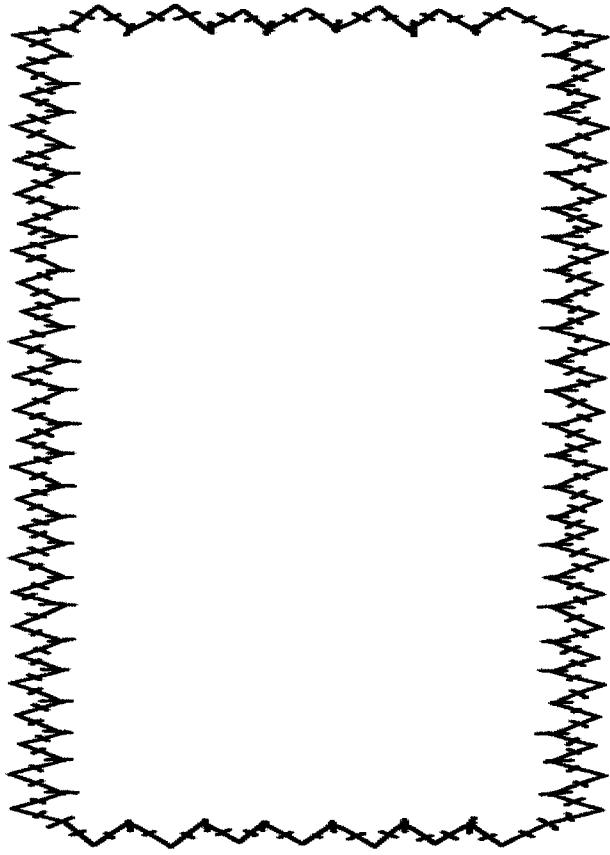


Non-Fictional Informational

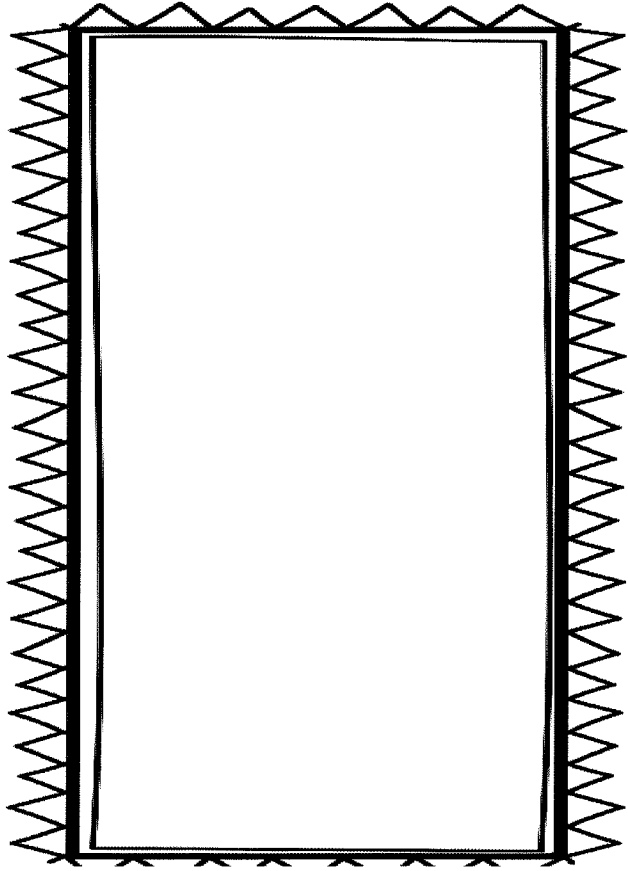


Historical Fiction

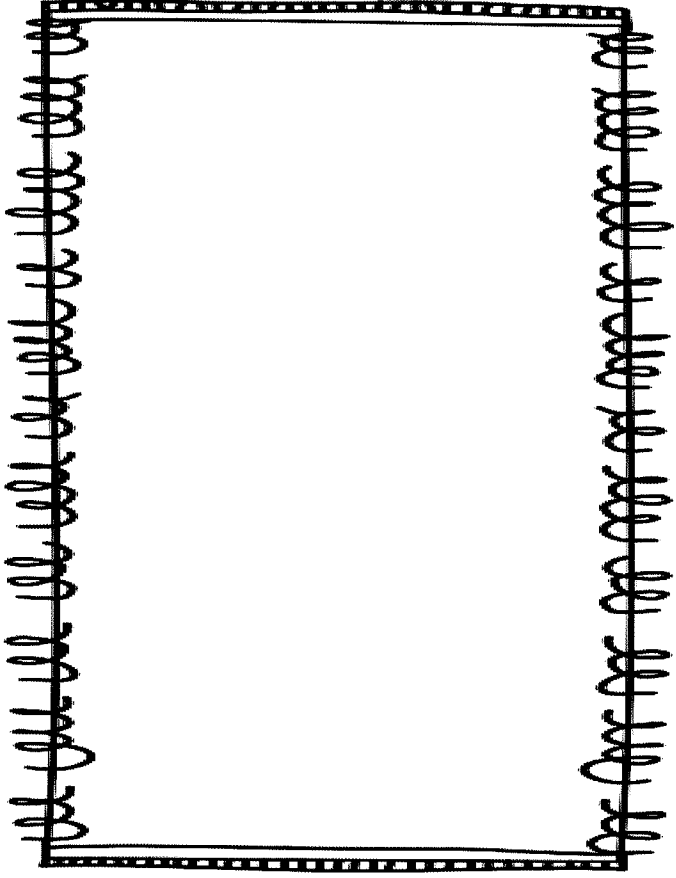


Autobiography

I read this AUTOBIOGRAPHY.

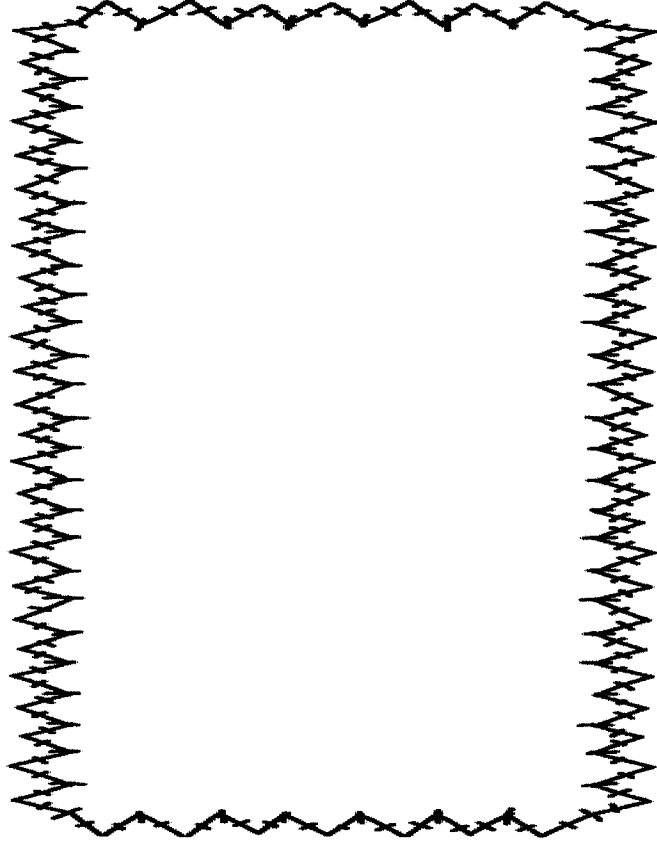

Poetry is verse written to create an emotional response. It often uses rhythm and rhyme.

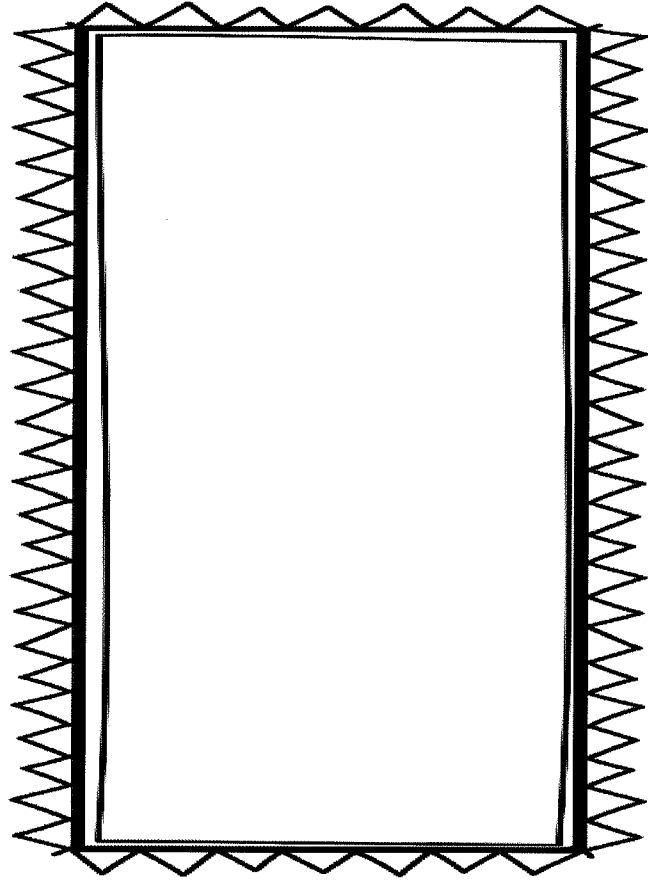

I read this MYSTERY book.

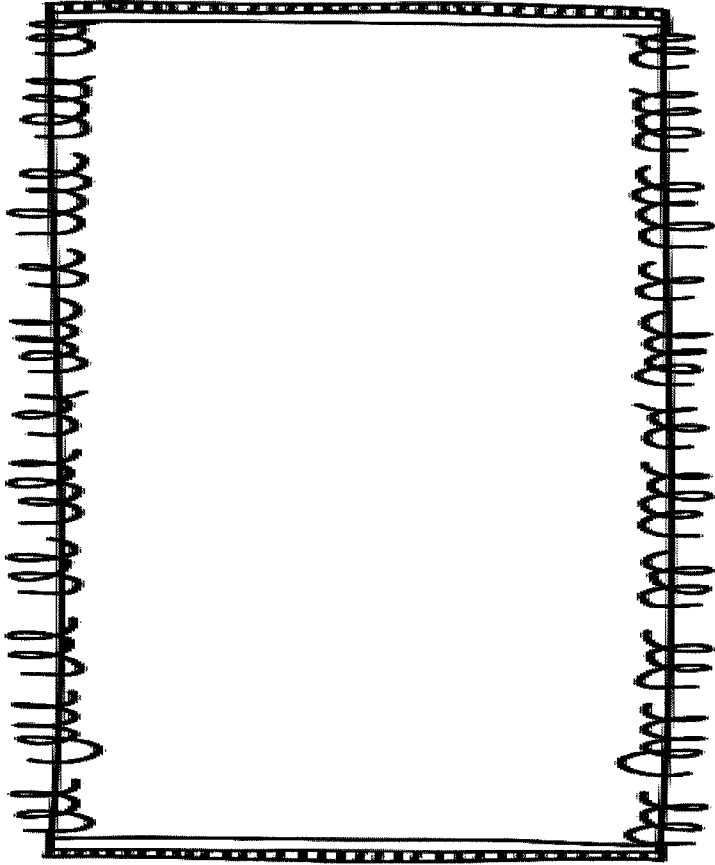


Biography

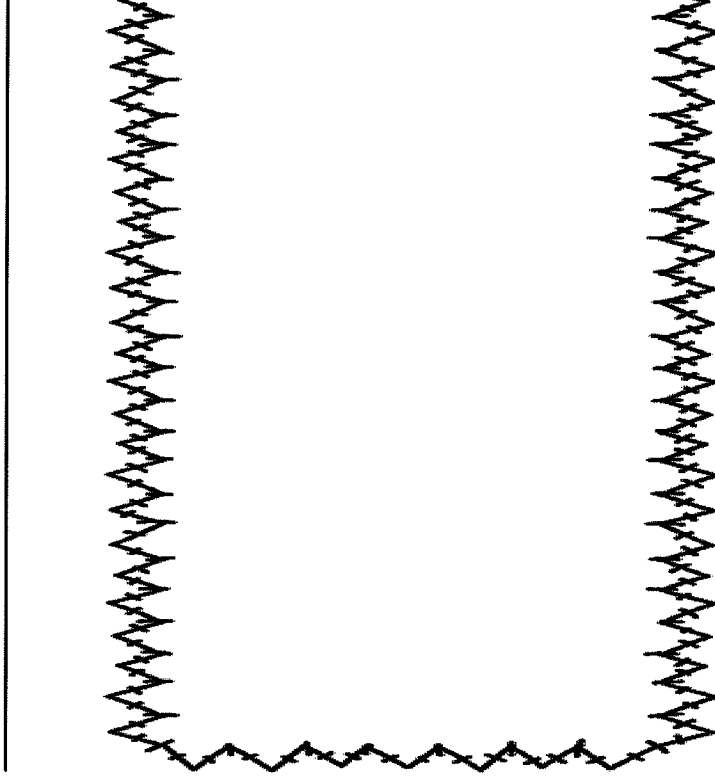


Realistic Fiction

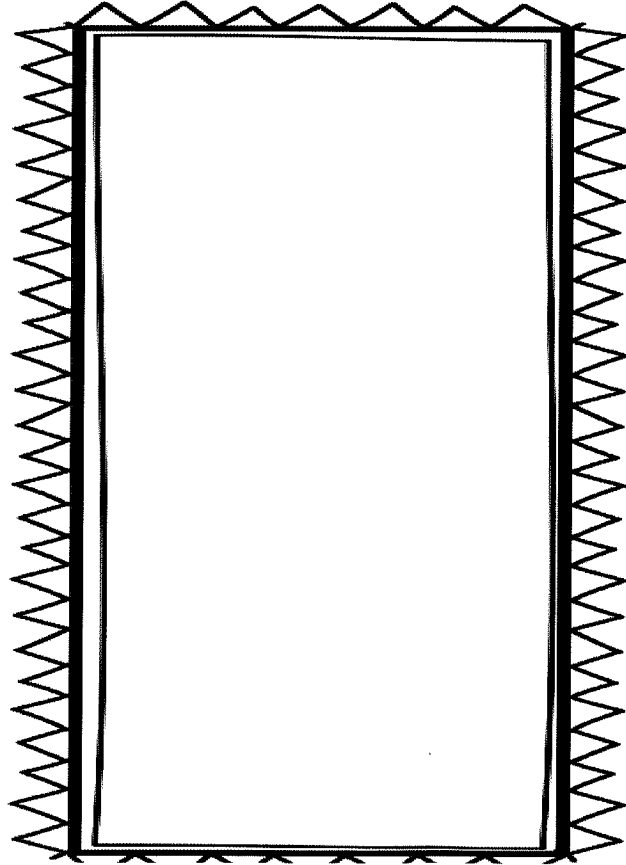


Science Fiction
