WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS

- 1. Kudos to Keysor:
 - a. A special thanks was given to some of our parent volunteers who have been working hard at keeping our events and sub-committees organized. Specifically mentioned were Tami McFall for her work on the BuzzBook, Elizabeth Coffin for organizing our restaurant nights, Carrie Chen for being our Room Volunteer Coordinator, and all of our Room volunteers who have stepped up to help out our classrooms and teachers.
- 2. <u>Administration Update</u>: From Dr. Taylor and Mr. Bridges
 - a. The first quarter ends on Friday, October 15th. Grades will be released on Infinite Campus on October 19th.
 - b. The book fair will be here October 18-21. This event raises funds for our Keysor library.
 - c. There will not be coordinated Halloween parties this year due to Covid. Each teacher will decide independently what they would like to do with their class for the holiday. The students WILL still participate in the traditional Halloween parade. Grades K-2 will have their parade in the morning. Grades 3-5 will have

their parade in the afternoon. Since the parade is held outdoors, families will be permitted to line up along the parade route.

d. We will be having a spirit week again this year where classes will bring in non-perishable donations for KirkCare. Details to follow.

3. <u>Racial Equity Spotlight:</u> Patty Fisher

- a. 4th Grade teacher Abby Chastian was the winner of the October Racial Equity Spotlight. A donation will be made in her honor to provide racially inclusive materials for the school.

- a. Keysor Cares is the Keysor outreach program designed to provide any student in need with supplies or materials they may otherwise not have access to. ALL assistance through Keysor Cares is completed anonymously. Examples of what Keysor Cares may provide are book fair money, ipad insurance, school supplies.
