Special Presentation

Levaughn Smart, Director of Safety and Security of Kirkwood School District

Mr. Smart provided an overview of our district policy on intruders and active shooters.

He provided an explanation of ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate). ALICE training provides individuals how to prepare and plan how to more proactively handle the threat of an aggressive intruder or active shooter event.

Mr. Smart provided how ALICE strategies work at Keysor. Keysor Kindergarten teacher, Maggie Perkins, also gave parents an insight on how she prepares students for the drills conducted at the school.

The district's safety procedures and policies already include a school crisis plan, security cameras, numbered exterior doors and classroom windows, and other measures. Kirkwood also participates in safety team meetings with the Webster Groves School District and area first responders.

While the state requires all schools to conduct one intruder drill a year, Kirkwood has four intruder drills a year.

Kirkwood has streamlined its communication between schools during emergencies using an app called "CrisisGo," which improves safety through advanced alerts, access to the district's emergency plans, better communication among school officials and more.
