REFUNDS / CREDIT ARE AVAILABLE UNDER THE FOLLOWING POLICY:

- 1. A program is cancelled by the Des Peres Parks and Recreation Department.
- 2. A registrant cannot participate due to a change in the program dates or times.
- 3. A registrant cannot participate due to a documented medical issue. A doctor's note must be submitted.
- 4. If registrant withdraws from the program before the second class.**
- 5. Camp Refund Policy: Registrant must withdraw by camp by the advertised registration deadline listed in the camp description in order to receive a full refund.**Any camp withdraws after the advertised registration deadline are charged a 75% cancellation fee.




