- 2) Mental Health and Prison reformers (Dorothea Dix)
- 3) Abolitionists (William Lloyd Garrison, Frederick Douglass, Harriet Tubman, Charles Finney. Make sure to discuss the American Colonization Society as well)
- 4) Education Reform (People: Horace Mann, Thomas Galludet, Catharine Beecher)

You will need to answer the following questions for each reform movement:

- 1) What was its purpose? What did it hope to achieve?
- 2) Who are the major figures involved in it?
- 3) Is there any dissent within the movement itself? What are the different viewpoints?
- 4) What aspects of society or events helped give rise to the movement?
