Questions

- 1) Outline the chain of events through which America entered WWI and the impact it left on the American economy and politics. In your answer discuss the following: U.S. reaction at the beginning of WWI; sinking of the Lusitania; the Zimmerman Telegram.
- 2) Discuss the assumptions underlying the Roosevelt Corollary. In your answer, describe how the doctrine affected our relations with European nations and those in the Western Hemisphere.
- 3) What did President Wilson mean by "moral imperialism", and what measures were taken to apply this to Latin America?
- 4) How did WWI and its aftermath provide African Americans with opportunities (in your answer, discuss the Great Migration)?
- 5) What connections can be made between America's pursuit of empire, the progressive movement, and the United States experience in WWI?
- 6) How did the role of women change during the war? (both politically and economically)
- 7) Explain the goals of the Committee on Public Information during WWI. Do we still use propaganda? Evaluate.
- 8) Describe how WWI and the U.S. failure to join the League of Nations sowed the seeds of future 20th century wars.
- 9) What were the major causes—both real and imaginary—of the Red Scare?
- 10) How did ratification of the 18th and 19th Amendments show the restrictive and democratizing nature of Progressivism?
