

## Sayville Middle School Dress Code

**In general, clothing must be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the education process.**

- No hats are to be worn in the building from when students enter in the morning until they leave at 3pm.
- No chains, spike bracelets, or other inappropriate accessories.
- No clothes may be worn that are vulgar, obscene, libelous or denigrate others on account of race, color, creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or disability. In general, we do not wear anything that puts down others.
- No clothes may be worn that advertise or promote alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs and/or encourage illegal or violent behaviors.
- Clothes must cover underwear even when seated. Bra straps are underwear.
- Clothes must cover midriff area even when seated (front and back).
- SKIRTS must be no more than 5 inches from the knee and anything shorter, must be covered by opaque leggings or bicycle shorts must be worn to the 5 inches or lower length.
- SHORTS must be no more than 5 inches from the knee and anything shorter, must be covered by opaque leggings or bicycle shorts must be worn to the 5 inches or lower length.
- TOPS: the straps must be at least an inch and a half wide and the top at least parallel to your underarm. No halter tops or strapless tops may be worn.
- No see-through tops may be worn.
- JEANS must be worn no lower than the hips. Ripped jeans follow the 5 inch rule. Any hole above 5 inches-must have opaque fabric underneath.
- No pajama pants
- No bedroom slippers
