# B. Superintendent Update

Mike Sheppard, Superintendent, gave an update regarding the following topics to the Board of Education

Superintendent's Update

### 1. District Facilities

- The Superintendent provided the Board of Education with an update regarding where the district is in a process to have community dialogue regarding updates to the district's facilities.
- Jeff Grosse presented a spreadsheet that provided preliminary concepts with estimated costs. Mr. Grosse went through each of the various options and requested feedback from the Board. The discussion included estimated enrollment, square footage per student and overall project costs.
- Mike Sheppard explained the need to go through the process, the anticipated future enrollment of the district and the current state of the existing buildings in the district.
- The members of the Board expressed their opinions on where the Board, Administration and Communities role should be in the process. In addition, the Board and Administration discussed different locations, what the community is wanting and what the process would be to accomplish the project in the timeline available.
- The Board has requested that several options be brought to the second Board Meeting in December to develop a plan to move forward with and engage in the community with.

 District Finances – Discussion about future tax levies regarding type, scope and timing

Superintendent's Update (continued)

- The Treasurer/CFO presented to the Board of Education an overview of projected changes to the five year forecast since the Board of Education approved the document in October. The most significant change in the current and subsequent forecast projections was a result of changes in legislation that resulted from S.B. 208. This bill provided the district with additional TPP supplement review in FY2017 by ensuing the district will not receive less than 94% of the combined state funding and TPP reimbursement review that was received in FY2015. In addition, the bill reduced the FY2018 and subsequent years phase out of the TPP reimbursement by almost half the annual amount.
- Mr. Ghizzoni also provided data from the soon to be released Meritorious Budget, that illustrated the district per pupil expenditure data and corresponding benchmark data in comparison to surrounding districts. The Treasurer explained the factors behind the variances and how they are effected by the district's operation and employment practices.

#### 3. District Initiatives

- Mike Sheppard discussed the progress that has been made with the Strategic Plan Committee, the release of a new phone survey to the community in the near future.
- Ana Chapman expressed her concern with doing the phone survey to a limited, random selection of community members rather than just doing an online survey that everyone is able to access at the same time.
- Mr. Sheppard also discussed the progress with the communication audit and the work that has been completed so far. Once the audit is complete, the District will formulate a plan to improve the communication districtwide.
