- (a) The Berea Board of Education intends to provide equal educational and employment opportunities without regard to race, color, creed, national origin, or sex as per the Civil Rights Act of 1965 and Title IX of 1972 Educational Amendments. It is recommended that the Director of Personnel & Employee Relations, be designated as the District's Civil Rights Compliance Officer and Title IX Hearing Officer.
- (b) The Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, hereby determines that no qualified handicapped individual in the United States, shall, solely by reason of his/her handicap, be excused from participation in, be denied benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance. It is recommended that the Director of Pupil Services, be designated as the Section 504 Coordinator.
- (c) Pursuant to the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act, Public Law 101-236, it is recommended that the Director of Pupil Services, be designated as the coordinator of responsibilities related to this Act.
- (d) Pursuant to the requirements of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act, it is recommended that the Assistant Superintendent, be the Designated Person to coordinate the asbestos responsibilities related to this act.
- (e) Pursuant to state and federal laws, it is recommended that the Director of Pupil Services, be designated as liaison for homeless students.

Section 1: The firms of Squire, Sanders & Dempsey; Britton, Smith, Peters & Kalail Co., LPA; Walter & Haverfield; and Peck, Schaeffer & Williams; be and are hereby retained, such legal services to be in the nature of legal representation, including, but not limited to, appearances in court, advice, opinions, and/or all phases of labor negotiations, appearances before the State Employment Relations Board and recommendations that may from time to time be requested by this Board or the Superintendent concerning legal matters relating to education and the operation of the school district. In rendering such legal services, as an independent contractor and in an attorney-client relationship, said firms, Squire, Sanders & Dempsey; Britton, Smith, Peters & Kalail Co., LPA; and Peck, Schaeffer & Williams shall not exercise any administrative discretion on behalf of this Board in the formulation of public policy, expenditure of public funds, enforcement of laws, rules and regulations of the State, any county or city or of this Board, or the execution of public trusts. Such services may be terminated at any time by the Board or the firms Squire, Sanders & Dempsey; Britton, Smith, Peters & Kalail Co., LPA; and Peck, Schaeffer & Williams by written notice to the other.

Section 2: For such legal consultative services, the firms of Squire, Sanders & Dempsey; Britton, Smith, Peters & Kalail Co., LPA; and Peck, Schaeffer & Williams shall be paid reasonable fees as approved by the Board, and shall be reimbursed for actual out-of-pocket expenses (including, but not limited to, travel, long distance telephone expenses, and duplicating expenses) incurred in rendering such services, from time to time for such purpose.
