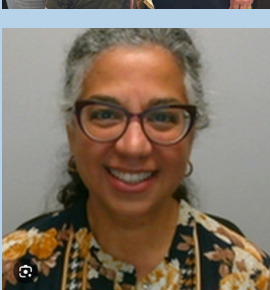
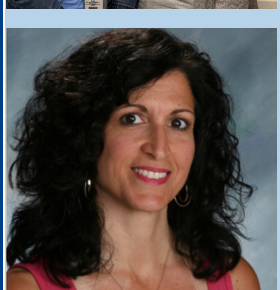
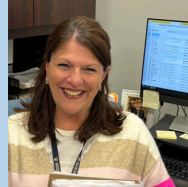


Superintendent's Corner
