

From the Health Office

All medications are to be picked up by the parent/guardian on the last day of school. Health Assistant, Sam Brooker, LPN, will be reaching out regarding parental consent to send home over the counter medications (ie. cough drops) home with your student(s). OASD Policy does not allow health staff to keep medications for the next school year. If there is NO response regarding the medication and they are not picked up/sent home by the end of the day on the last day of school, May 31st, the medication will be properly disposed of.

If your child has a current health plan or emergency plan on file with the school, you will receive a copy during the summer to update for the upcoming school year.

If your child has a change in their health or has a healthcare need at school, please email our school district nurse, Maria Vanderlinden, BSN, RN, during the summer and she will contact you at the beginning of the school year to discuss. Maria.Vanderlinden@oshkosh.k12.wi.us

If your child will need to take medication at school, please work with your doctor to have the following form completed and signed before the start of the school year. As a reminder, the directions on the medication bottle must match the written order on the medication request form.
