Who Qualifies?

Pre-K Qualification:

4-years-old on or before September 1, 2024

Kindergarten Qualification:

5-years-old on or before September 1, 2024

Pre-Kindergarten & Kindergarten in CCISD

★ **FREE Pre-K for Qualifying Families**

★ **Tuition-Based Pre-K Program**

- \$600/month (over 10 months) \$6000 a year
- Application Window Closed (Nov 2023 - Feb 1, 2024)

Do You Qualify for FREE Pre-K?

To Qualify Your Child Must:

- Reside in CCISD
- Turn 4 years old on or before September 1, 2024

And Meet One of the Following Criteria:

- Limited English Proficiency
- Economically Disadvantaged
- Homeless
- The child of a parent in the military or injured or killed while actively serving in the military
- Have been in the conservatorship of the state of Texas
- The child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award (as a peace officer, firefighter, emergency medical first responder)

How To Enroll

Determine/Confirm Qualifying Status:

- Pre-K: 4-years old by September 1
- Kindergarten: 5-years old by September 1
- Qualify for Free Pre-K or Tuition

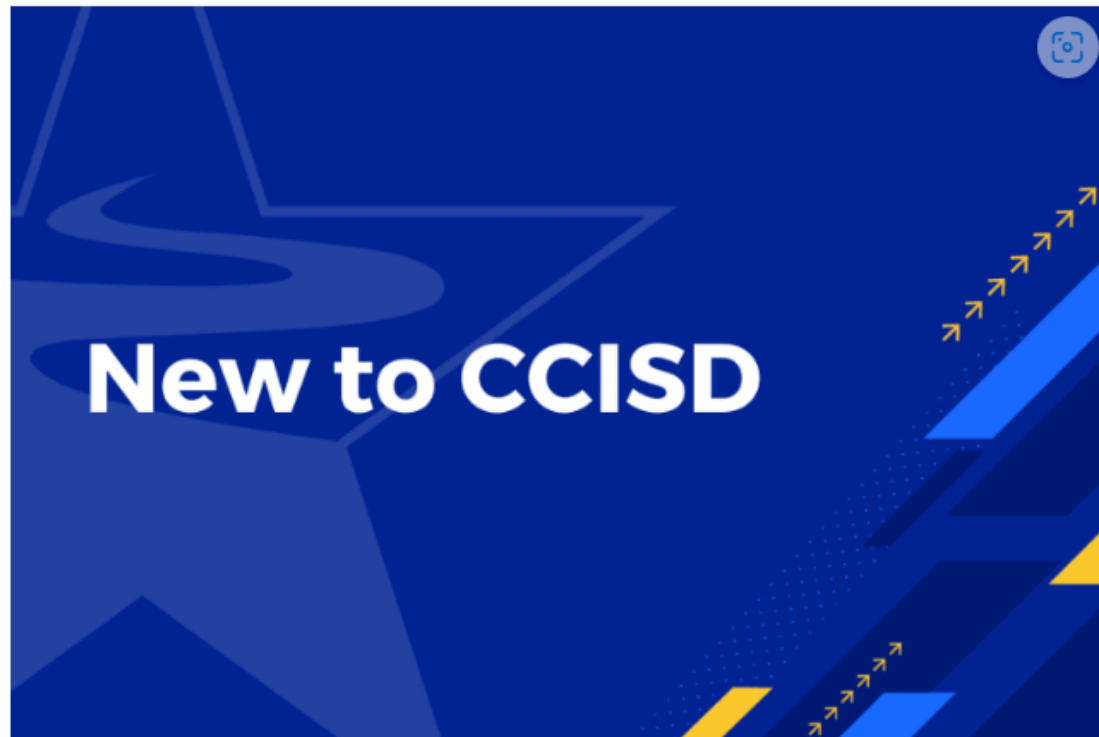
Pre-Kindergarten Enrollment

To qualify for Pre-Kindergarten as a four-year old, the child must be four on or before September 1 and live within the District's boundaries. Follow the steps below to enroll.

Kindergarten Enrollment

To qualify for Kindergarten, students must be five years of age on or before September 1 and live within the District's boundaries.

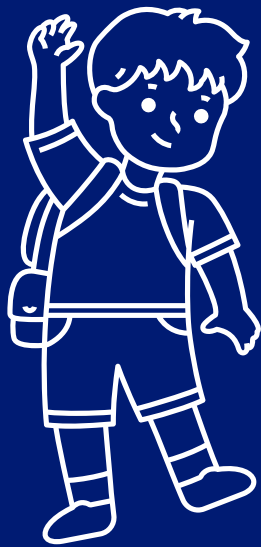

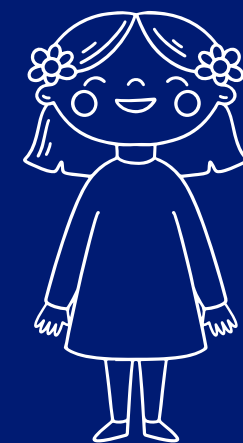

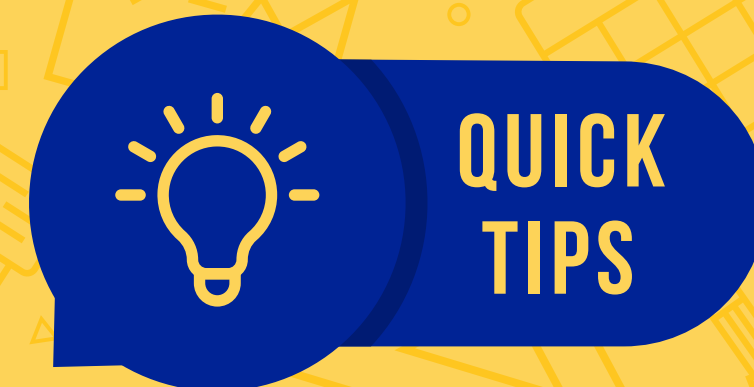
2. Create an I LOVE YOU ritual in preparation for saying goodbye on the first day
