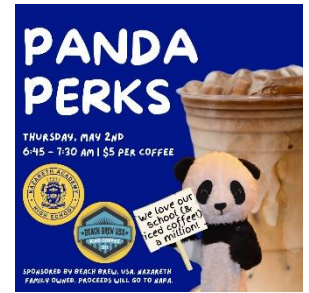


Senior Farewell - General Parent Meeting 5/7

Panda Perks – May 2nd

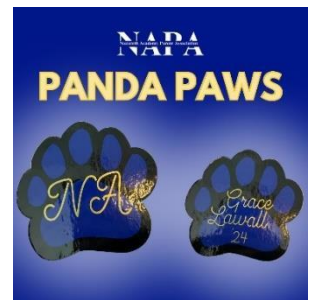
