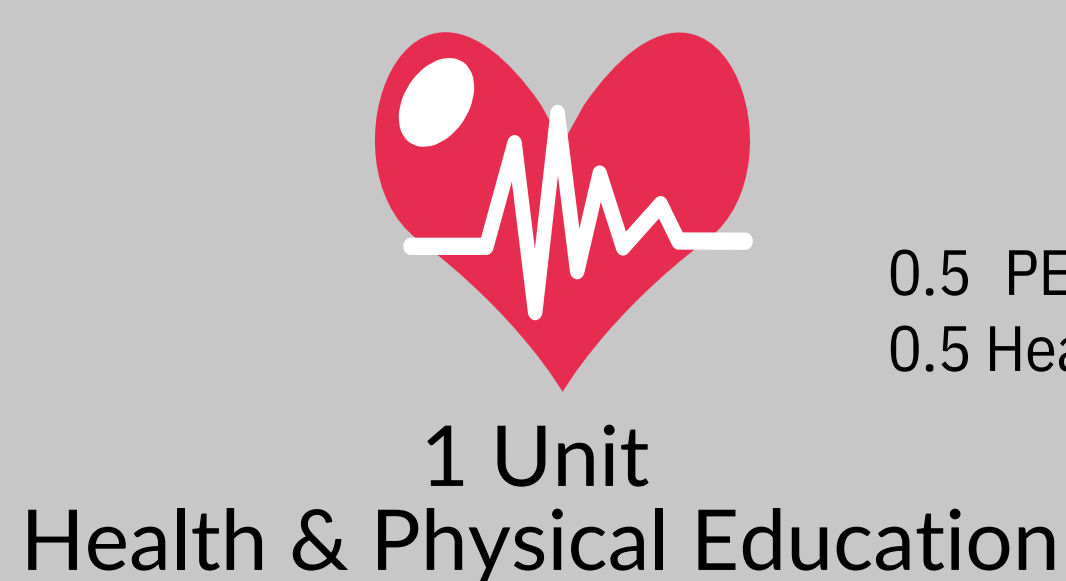
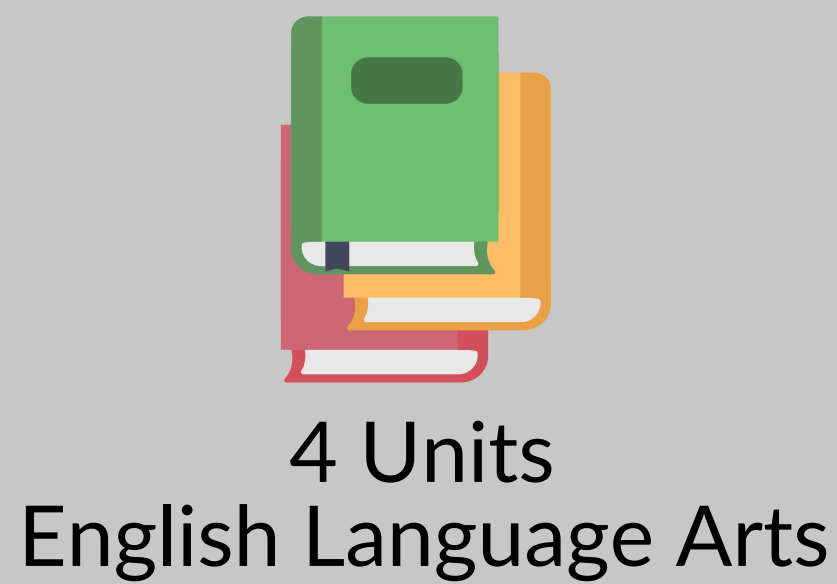
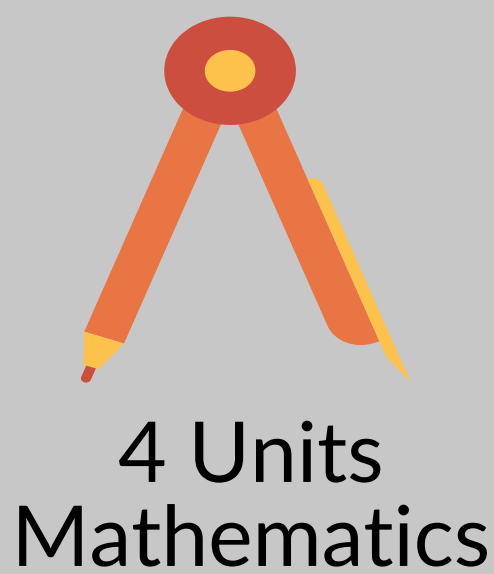

# FIRST

## Basics

### 1. Course Completion

Students will satisfy Ohio's curriculum requirements and any additional local requirements. Students will complete the state minimum 20 units, with specific units required in each content area.



Must include:  
0.5 U.S. History  
0.5 Government  
0.5 World History

Must include:  
1 Physical Science  
1 Life Science  
1 Advanced Science

0.5 PE (or 2 waivers)  
0.5 Health

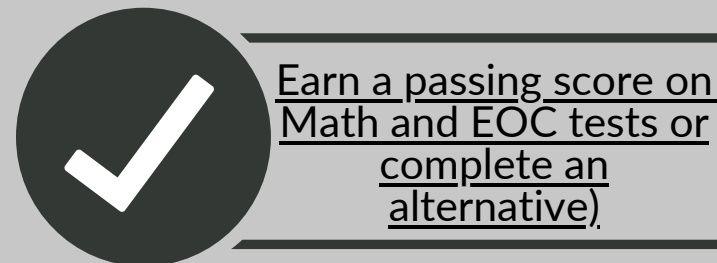
Your home school may require more than 5 electives. Be sure to check.

# SECOND

## Competency

### 2. Demonstrating Competency

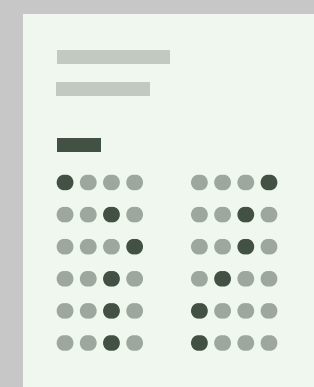
Students will demonstrate competency in the foundational areas of English language arts and mathematics or through alternative demonstrations, which include College Credit Plus, career-focused activities, their ACT or SAT scores, or military enlistment.



Students must take Algebra I/Math I and English II/Language Arts end-of-course tests and earn a minimum score of 684



ALTERNATIVES  
Before being eligible to demonstrate competency in one of these, students first must receive remediation and retake the test.



**Demonstrate Two Career-Focused Activities\*:**

**Foundational**

1. Proficient scores on WebXams (Pass 3 or more)
2. Earn a 12-point industry credential
3. A pre-apprenticeship or acceptance into an approved apprenticeship program
4. Obtain a state-issued license for practice in a vocation that requires an examination.

**Supporting**

1. Complete a 250-hour work-based learning experience with evidence of positive evaluations;
2. Earn the workforce readiness score on WorkKeys\*; or
3. Earn the OhioMeansJobs-Readiness Seal.

\*At least one must be foundational

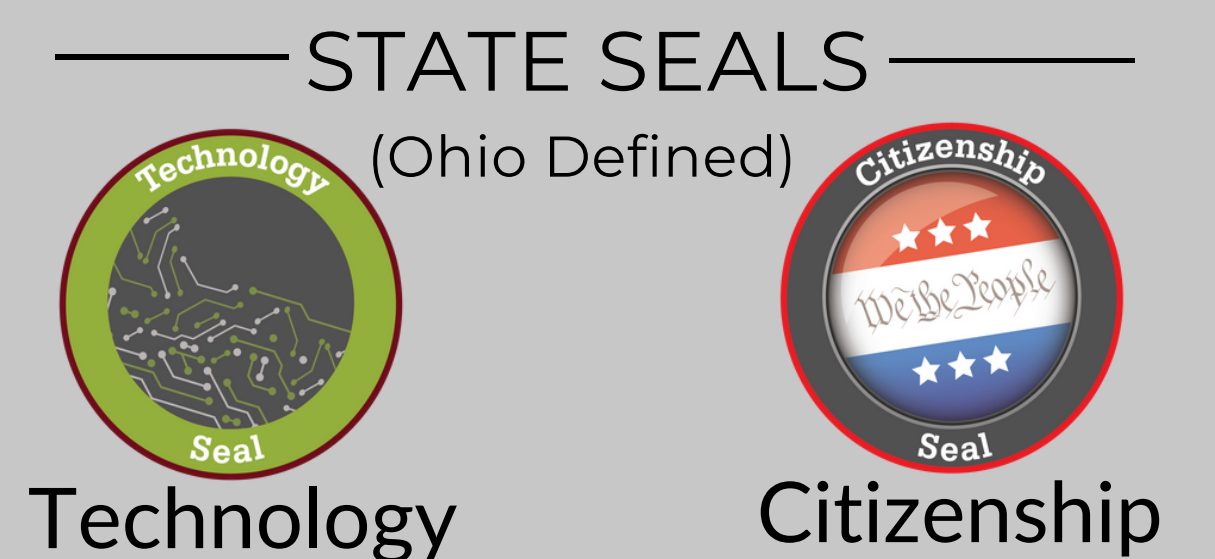
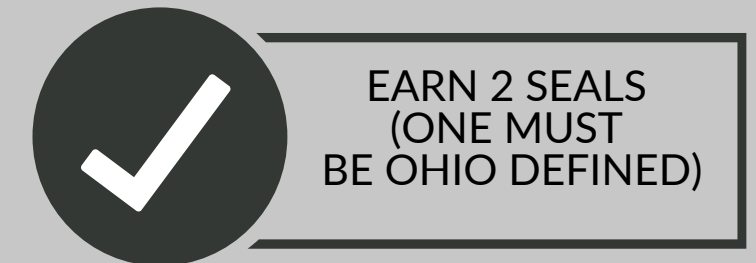

### 3. Demonstrating Readiness (Seals)

Students will demonstrate readiness for their post-high school paths by earning two diploma seals that allow them to demonstrate important foundational and well-rounded academic and technical knowledge, professional skills, and leadership and reasoning skills.



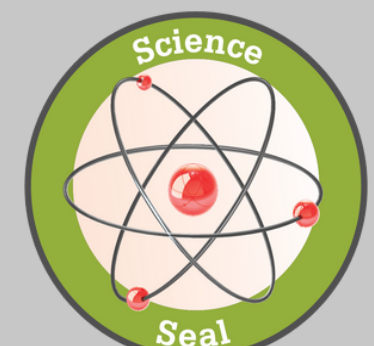

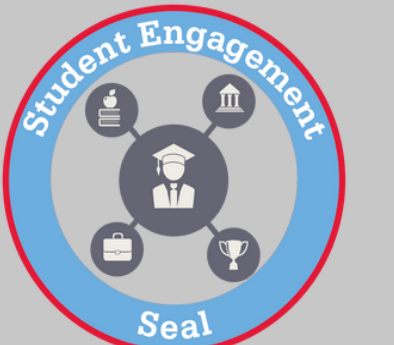
