
- On designated testing dates, please assist us by ensuring that your **child's device is fully charged** and that they also **bring their charging cord each day** as well.
- Students are not permitted to have any electronic devices, apart from their districtissued Chromebook, for testing and allowable calculators for specified portions of the exams in certain grade levels per the policy.
- Students should arrive to school on time, as testing will begin promptly at 8:40 am.
- Students will be tested online via a district-provided Chromebook on school premises, unless an accommodation is in place that would require paper/pencil assessments.
 Students will need a pair of wired headphones/earbuds, which can plug into the device (e.g.: not Bluetooth) to assist with the directions and prompting for the assessment.
 Test these headphones in advance on your child's district-issued device if you have one.

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Car Rider Reminders:

This is a friendly reminder to follow our car line procedures outlined at the beginning of the school year.

- All cars should follow the traffic pattern shown in the image below. Cars are not permitted to leave the drop off line (i.e. passing cars).
- Students should exit the car on the passenger side for safety reasons.
- Students arriving *after 8:35 am are considered tardy*. If a car rider arrives after 8:35 am, the student should enter through the main entrance doors for a tardy pass. If there is a delay with the car rider line, we will continue to keep the car rider line open.
