This year's essay focuses on: The Future of a College Education- Will It Be Obsolete?

In the form of a TIK TOK - style video, please address the following questions: "What are your views on the future of higher education?" "How will the youth of today respond to these changes?" "Is a higher education degree still worth obtaining? Show or tell us why!

- 1. The scholarship is open to graduating male and female students with a minimum 3.0 GPA enrolled at an Orangeburg or Calhoun County School
- 2. Complete the application portion and submit supporting documents
- 3. The entry must be in the form of a video created/composed by the student submitting. Acceptable forms include poem, song, rap, spoken word or expressive art
- 4. Student should be dressed in business professional or business casual attire
- 5. The video should be a minimum of 2 minutes and no more than 4 minutes in length
- 6. No profanity or vulgar language, hand/body gestures are allowed
- 7. The student should introduce themselves and include: title of the performed piece, name of student's school, name of principal, and name of sponsoring chapter, (Delta Chi Sigma Chapter, Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.) The introduction time does not count towards the length of the video.
- 8. Upload the video using the link on the application.
