This table summarizes the counts and percentages of overlap across the identified student groups. Of all 13,978 TK-12 district students, 71.4% (9,980) are included in at least one California LCFF-identified student group. The percentages for the table should be read by row, e.g. among PUSD's 9,787 socio-economically disadvantaged students, 17.1% of them (1,678 students) are also identified as English Learners.
