

Springtime Alert: April Marks Alcohol Awareness Month - Let's Talk Teen Drinking!

Happy Springtime Knights! April is Alcohol Awareness Month, and it's crucial to address teen drinking, especially with Prom and Graduation approaching. Parents' attitudes play a significant role in



shaping teen behavior, with about 80% feeling parents should have a say in their alcohol consumption. Binge drinking, defined as 4 or more drinks for females and 5 or more for males in about 2 hours, poses serious risks, including cognitive impairment and lifelong substance abuse issues. **Click here** to learn more about starting the conversation with your teen through SAMHSA's 'Talk They Hear You' campaign.
