





This information is for current NMUSD students only. Students coming from outside of our district may not be able to tryout for ASB, yearbook, or pep squad because of internal scheduling needs.





## **Middle School**






Students take a math transition benchmark test in May at their elementary school. This test, along with student SBAC scores and other academic criteria places students in the appropriate math class. Elementary school teachers do not give recommendations, nor do we take outside recommendations. The district will send home a letter during the summer disclosing your child's placement. Students who are new to the district have an opportunity to take a placement test on August 13th at 9:30am.






