



Jaguar Girls and Boys Track & Field team secured another Win over Centennial. They shared Identical scores of 81 Aprende 19 Centennial. Hurdlers started the strike off with Amayla Burnett 1st (200 winner too) Jaida Williams 2nd place and Jaiyana "J.J." Bogan 3rd going 1, 2 3 to set the pace. JJ also Wins the shot put. Natalia Alvarez was a Triple winner in 100 meters a huge PR (personal record) 400 meters and Long Jump. Aliyah Carden Captures the 800 win. Marina Jovanovic step down in distance to sprint but still manages to win the Discus.

Our boys continue to dominate in sprints with Landon Washington leading the way to win the 100 meters and anchoring the 4x100 relay, combine effort with Royale Mandley, Nicholas Jacoby and Jeremy Larson. Open Enrollment

Kyrene School District offers online enrollment for new students and any student applying to change schools. New or transferring students who live outside of a school's boundaries must fill out an application via the online registration portal. Open Enrollment must be approved before registration is considered final.

Current Students

Current families with no school changes and no new students will not need to re-register. Children in grades K-4 and 6-7 will continue to be registered at the same school they currently attend. Current 5th graders will automatically be registered at the middle school assigned to follow their current elementary school.

Families who want to make an enrollment change to a school other than the one assigned are strongly encouraged to submit applications for your preferred school by January 15. To make a change, log into your ParentVUE account and select the "change school" option.

For **current families with new students** entering school, online registration will be available through your existing ParentVUE account.


