## Follow Junior Year Timeline

- Review past College Planning Night events
- Review Khan Academy's Applying to College Course
- Register with NCAA Eligibility Center for D1 or D2 athletics
- Research college admission/testing requirements. Is your college test-optional?
- Create an appropriate SAT/ACT testing timeline
- Research <u>summer enrichment</u> programs
- Update your resume
- Complete and return Parent Signature Form (Sapphire)
  - Annually
- Attend a Summer Workshop (Mrs. Whalen will send an invitation)
  - View past <u>workshops</u>

# Letters of Recommendation

#### Ask 2 core academic teachers

- Ask your teachers in person before the end of the school year
- Teachers can say no to writing your letter!
- Follow their process for letters of recommendation
- Give your teachers plenty of time to write a letter in the fall
- Add teacher requests in Naviance
  - Follow <u>Naviance directions</u> (These will be updated this summer)
  - Naviance does not open until August
- <u>FERPA Waiver:</u> You are waiving/not waiving your right to petition your college to view your letter of recommendation

Follow application directions.

Many colleges no longer require

or accept letters of

recommendation.

(Pitt, Penn State, Clemson, VT, USC, Arizona State, etc.)

#### Remember:

If a college does not require a letter of recommendation, it may not be reviewed in the admission process.

# **Applying To College**

#### When can you apply?

- You can start working on the Common Application now.
- Most applications officially open on August 1

### Where is the application?

- Look on each college website under Admission Apply
- Search for schools on the Common App. Over 1,000 are listed.
- Applications are *not* in Naviance

## What Do We Use Naviance For?

#### Sending the following information to colleges/technical/community colleges:

- High school profile
- Transcript
- Senior Year schedule
- Secondary school report form
- Mid-year grades (if required)
- School counselor/teacher letters of recommendation
- Final transcript
