# What is Naviance Student?









Naviance Student is a comprehensive 7-12 college and career readiness platform that enables self-discovery, career exploration, academic planning, and college preparation.

Through Naviance, each student creates an electronic portfolio of college and career experiences to help make post-secondary decisions that align with his/her talents, interest and aspirations.

PRHS also uses Naviance to electronically send documents to colleges, technical schools and the NCAA Clearinghouse.















Naviance Student is accessible anywhere. While many of the features are familiar, it has been redesigned to provide students the opportunity to engage in college and career planning more effectively and on any of their devices.





**AchieveWorks** Personality® helps students by asking students to


identify their personality type choose scenarios that best represent how they behave in real life.

StrengthsExplorer® will help uncover talents and reveal potential strengths that students can use on their journey through college, career and life.


AchieveWorks Learning and Productivity® helps identify sensory and mindset preferences so students can find out how they learn best and how to be most productive.

**Career Interest Profiler** captures self-reported interests to help determine personality traits and aligned careers based on the U.S. Department of Labor's data.




Students use assessments to match their personalities and interests with potential careers.







The school counseling office uses Naviance to electronically send the PRHS Profile, student transcripts, teacher letters of recommendation, senior year schedules, mid-year grades, and final transcripts to colleges and technical schools.


Students and parents can monitor requests by checking their accounts.

Naviance does not send SAT, ACT or AP scores. Most colleges require students send scores directly from the testing agency.


#### Planner: Tasks Assigned to Me


