



Delta Parents:

Congratulations on your student's admission into this amazing program. As the school nurse, I oversee health conditions, medication administration, and immunization compliance. Please read over this document very carefully. Incomplete health information and immunization records could result in a delay in your student starting school in the Fall.

Required Documents before starting school: (Missing required information will result in a hold on your student's school schedule).

- Updated Health History, completed online in PowerSchool. (PSD students please update/KDS and RSD, please register).

Health Conditions:

- Please notify the nurse of any health conditions that may affect your student's learning through the registration process.
- **LIFE THREATENING CONDITION** students need a plan in place and emergency medicine, if necessary, **BEFORE** attending school. Please specify this when you register and I will reach out to you with more information.

Medications:

- Per school policy, any medication (even over the counter medication) needs to have authorization from a medical provider. Please inform the nurse if your student will need medications at school even if your student plans to self-carry the medication we need a form filled out by your student's doctor.
- If you are getting medication orders together earlier than the end of this school year, please have the doctor specify that the order is for the 2024/2025 school year. Paperwork available on Delta's website.

**Washington School Immunization Law (RCW 28.A.31.118) requires that the parent must certify with dates that the student is properly immunized or sign a personal or religious exemption that is also signed by a Healthcare provider. If an exemption is signed and a disease outbreak for which your child is exempted occurs, the child will be excluded from school for the duration of the outbreak as determined by the Health Department.
