


Learning About Myself - Interests


Students will need to be logged into their Google accounts to access Career Planner

For those who have not accessed Career Planner before:


1. Click Google Apps
2. Click on “More” at the bottom of the menu
3. Scroll to the bottom and Select “Career Planner”
4. Click on “Career Planner” again to get into the program



In the “Learning About Myself” section, there are three self-assessment sections for students to complete: Preferences, Interests and Skills.



Students have the opportunity to complete each section FOUR (4) times. As a student completes each section, the **OVERVIEW** will look like the below image:

Similar to the Preferences self-assessment, students will complete the 60 question assessment by choosing whether they would **like doing it**, **dislike doing it**, or **are not sure** each activity.

Occupational Personality Types

 <h4>Artistic - The "Creators"</h4> <p>People with Artistic interests like work activities that deal with the artistic side of things, such as forms, designs and patterns. They like self-expression in their work. They prefer settings where work can be done without following a clear set of rules.</p> <p>EXAMPLE CAREERS Actors, Animators and Multimedia Artists, Architects</p>	 <h4>Conventional - The "Organizers"</h4> <p>People with Conventional interests like work activities that follow set procedures and routines. They prefer working with data and detail more than with ideas. They prefer work in which there are precise standards rather than work in which you have to judge things by yourself. These people like working where the lines of authority are clear.</p> <p>EXAMPLE CAREERS Accountants and Auditors, Actuaries, Archivists</p>	 <h4>Enterprising - The "Persuaders"</h4> <p>People with Enterprising interests like work activities that have to do with starting up and carrying out projects, especially business ventures. They like persuading and leading people and making decisions. They like taking risks for profit. These people prefer action rather than thought.</p> <p>EXAMPLE CAREERS Administrative Services Managers, Advertising Managers, Advertising Salespeople</p>
 <h4>Investigative - The "Thinkers"</h4> <p>People with Investigative interests like work activities that have to do with ideas and thinking more than with physical activity. They like to search for facts and figure out problems mentally rather than to persuade or lead people.</p> <p>EXAMPLE CAREERS Aerospace Engineers, Agricultural Engineers, Agricultural Scientists</p>	 <h4>Realistic - The "Do-ers"</h4> <p>People with Realistic interests like work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They enjoy dealing with plants, animals and real-world materials, like wood, tools and machinery. They enjoy outside work. Often people with Realistic interests do not like careers that mainly involve doing paperwork or working closely with others.</p> <p>EXAMPLE CAREERS Agricultural Inspectors, Agricultural Products Graders and Sorters, Aircraft Mechanics</p>	 <h4>Social - The "Helpers"</h4> <p>People with Social interests like work activities that assist others and promote learning and personal development. They prefer to communicate more than to work with objects, machines or data. They like to teach, to give advice, to help or otherwise be of service to people.</p> <p>EXAMPLE CAREERS Acupuncturists, Addictions Counselors, Adult and Vocational Education Teachers</p>
