

New CCP Student Information

Criteria for Participation

Interested students and their parents should follow the steps below to determine eligibility to participate in CCP.

1. Attend an information session (February 22 2024)
 - Complete the [Intent to Participate](#) form and return to the high school by April 1, 2024. (This will need to be completed annually)
2. File a [CCP application](#) with Lakeland Community College or Lake Erie College [CCP application](#)
3. Complete [this permission slip](#) with a parent signature. Send the completed form to CCPinfo@lakelandcc.edu if applying to Lakeland Community College.
4. Submit a high school transcript or middle school grade report. **Mrs. Jurick will send this over for you once the Intent to Participate form has been turned in.**
5. Determine eligibility and placement:
 - **Students entering grades 10, 11 or 12 with an unweighted, cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or above will be admitted into the CCP program. For more information, read the [math and English placement summary](#). If the student does not have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, a placement test will need to be scheduled. 6. If you will be taking the ACCUPLACER test*, [review the free resources available on our test preparation website](#).
7. Once accepted, complete the CCP orientation online (Lakeland). 8. [Schedule an appointment](#) to meet with a Lakeland counselor to select classes and register.

***To participate in math courses through CCP, students must have successfully completed Algebra 2 and placed into college-level math.**

Student Accommodation Center

From then on, you will be asked to make your accommodation requests known for subsequent semesters during the priority registration period. If you miss priority registration, there may be a delay in getting your accommodations in place. Academic accommodations can be requested at any point in the academic term, however, accommodations cannot be applied retroactively and some accommodations may take additional time to put into place.
