 - Ms. Nicole Brough from Hosanna Industries spoke - Located on Dickey Road in Gibsonia, the goal of Hosanna is to spread the word to get local community volunteers. Hosanna is a local faith based non-profit that has served Western PA for 33 years. Hosanna, among other things, performs home based repairs, wheelchair access ramps to individuals in need. They serve 110-130 individuals per year. They also do disaster relief. Hosanna does not charge the homeowner for any repairs. Hosanna is dfunded by donations and private foundations. Hosanna workers include staff members and private volunteers.
 - Hosanna is looking for volunteers, summer staff, individuals learning trades and how to build, as well as fundraising. Hosanna wants to get families and the community more involved in serving this community – helping to spread the word about what Hosanna does. Join summer staff.
 - Hosanna serves the elderly community. Nicole is trying to start a Mom's for Mission Group (Facebook group) – go to sites and do landscaping, involving children, putting toiletries in homes that were built. There are volunteer opportunities for 15 and above to help build. There are a lot of other opportunities for younger kids.
 - Most of the people served have an income of no more than \$20,000.

- Hosanna is contacted a lot by UPMC. Habitat for Humanity contacts Hosanna to do repairs because Habitat for Humanity doesn't do repairs.
