To qualify, students must:

- 1. Meet GPA and College Academic Distribution Requirements or 'CADR'.
 - a. Minimum of 3.0 GPA
 - b. CADR are specific to Math, English, Science, Social Studies, World Languages and Fine Arts, and include number of credits and types of courses taken in each area. - 2. Ensure that their contact information can be released to higher education institutions. The information that will be released for the GAP includes,
 - a. First Name
 - b. Last Name
 - c. Date of Birth
 - d. Email(s) on record (school, personal)
 - e. Mailing Address
 - f. Cumulative GPA

To allow your student's information above to be released to universities participating in GAP, the box next to 'Release student directory information to colleges and other institutions of higher learning? Must be checked as 'Yes' in Synergy ParentVUE. If checked 'No' the information will not be released.

To verify or change the release option for your student, go to <u>ParentVUE</u> Under **'Student Information'** find **'Student Information Release'**.

Go to 'Institutions of Higher Learning', then 'Release student directory information to colleges and other institutions of higher learning?' Verify that the box is checked 'YES' if you want information to be released to GAP or 'NO' if you do not.

Information will be released to the Guaranteed Admissions Program (GAP) starting in early November. Please ensure that your Student Information Release permissions are updated (If necessary) by **October 31, 2022**

Starting in December, participating students in the 11° grade will receive communications from participating colleges and universities with information about the admissions process.

Participating students in the 12th grade will receive communication about their eligibility for guaranteed admissions or if not eligible, information to support them through the general admissions process.
