1. Describe the host's educational oversight to ensure students with disabilities are educated in the least restrictive environment while in the 1306 facility? (If not a host, answer as if you were.)

Under § 1306 of the PA School Code, the host school district (the school district where the children's institution is physically located) is required to allow a nonresident student in a children's institution to attend the public schools of the host school district until the student receives a diploma or completes the school term in which they turn 21. The host school district is responsible for providing the educational program for students, including students with disabilities who are placed in that facility, and for ensuring the provision of a free appropriate public education (FAPE) for eligible children with IEPs in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) (20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq.) and for gualified handicapped students with Service Agreements in accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 701 et seq.) and 22 PA Code Chapter 15. Also, the host is responsible to keep the resident district informed of any information needed to support the student. The District provides a continuum of intervention levels and placement options for its students with disabilities. The District joins with the Capital Area Intermediate Unit and its neighboring districts through the Dauphin County Consortium (Lower Dauphin, Derry Township, Central Dauphin, Steelton-Highspire, Susquehanna Township and Middletown) to provide programs for all students with disabilities in the least restrictive environment. The Harrisburg School District currently does not have 1306 facilities. In the event that a facility would locate within the District, the District would fully comply with the requirements of IDEA 2004 and PA Chapter 14 to meet its obligations under Section 1306 of the Public School Code as outlined in the BEC: Educational Programs for Students in Non-Educational Placements 22 Pa. Code Section. The District would be responsible to ensure that Child Find is utilized in the facility, appropriate IEPs are developed for those students that gualify for services, and ensure that students are in an appropriate educational placement. Should the Harrisburg School District become a host District, we would provide services through certified staff including special education teachers, speech and language therapists, occupational therapists and physical therapists.

2. Describe the district's procedures for communicating with 1306 facilities and how the district ensures a successful transition back to school? The Harrisburg School District attempts to collaborate with all team members to ensure student's needs are being met as outlined in the Individualized Education Plans (IEP) and in the least restrictive environment. The District is invited to each IEP meeting and is provided copies of all progress reports, RRs, and IEPs, regardless of attendance. The District and the Out of District (ODD) licensed social worker are invited and participate in team meetings and discharge meetings which include transition planning.

- 1. Describe the system of oversight the District would implement to ensure that all incarcerated students who may be eligible for special education are located, identified, evaluated and when deemed eligible, are offered a free appropriate public education (FAPE). The Harrisburg School District does not presently have any detention centers or incarceration facilities within its district boundaries. Should that occur, the district would provide services through the experienced qualified staff of special educators, speech and language therapists, and occupational and physical therapists. If the district is unable to provide FAPE, we would work collaboratively with various outside agencies or facilities to meet our students' needs successfully. Of course those recommendations are made through the IEP process. If a student would need related services the district will contract with the consortium, an agency or the IU. We would keep open lines of communication with probation and parole officers to ensure that they are at all special education, progress reports and IEP's are received on a regular basis and filed at the district office. Information is sent as needed to the incarceration facilities to ensure an appropriate education is provided. The district maintains contact with such facilities to check on student progress, toward graduation, including reviewing graduation plans within student IEP's. The Harrisburg School District issues diplomas to students who show evidence of completing course requirements or completion of IEP goals and objectives in adult correction facility.

#### Least Restrictive Environment

1. Review the district's data for Least Restrictive Environment. Highlight areas of improvement.

The SPP Indicator 5, Educational Environments according to the Special Education Data Report (SEDR) the district percentage is 17.6% lower than the state average for students served in the general education setting for 80% or more of the day. For students served in the general education setting for 40-79% of the day the district percentage is 12.3 % which is above the state average of 9.6%. The IEP team members consider general education programming with supplementary aids and services as an initial option and must be rejected by the team based upon data. When considering a more restrictive environment, the IEP team members must discuss and document the interventions utilized. Camp Curtin Academy, students in the full-time Learning Support, Emotional Support, Autism and Life Skills have been included in general education classes for science and social studies. Foose Elementary School, inclusion is part of the building's Comprehensive Plan for the full-time Autism, Learning Support and Life Skills classes. Due to COVID during the 2021-22 school year the inclusion model was unable to be implemented to its full capacity. In the 2022-23 school year students in these settings will be included for morning meetings, science and social studies with their general education peers. Ben Franklin Elementary held their first inclusion day, This was a presentation done via zoom. The presentation discussed things like what inclusion means and why it is important. Why it is important to use alternative words to the "R" word? As well as what Autism is and how students can interact and become friends with our students with autism. After the presentation students worked together to create posters on inclusion as well as infinity symbols that will be used to create an autism acceptance tree by our main office. The District is committed to provide staff (both general and special) with training and consultation on inclusive practices generally and specifically for students with complex support needs. For students in SpEd and other settings the districts average is 8.4% and the district acknowledges it's much higher average above the states average of 4.8%. The district participates in 45 Day review with OOD Licensed Social Worker as well as review the number of special education students returning to the District from outside placements monthly.

2. What universal practices does the district utilize to address the academic and social/emotional needs of all students in need of accommodations to their learning environments?

The Harrisburg School District has a variety of academic intervention programs available, such as 95% Group, Heggerty and IXL. In addition, current content series Open Court has intervention level materials that are utilized to assist with inclusion of students with learning disabilities and myPerspectives can be differentiated using leveled texts and they practice and re-teach activities. The district focused the implementation of school-wide PBIS supports and interventions; adopted Second Steps and utilizes school counselors to provide classroom- and school-wide SEL lessons; and uses community-based organizations/agencies to support mental health/social/emotional needs. In the practice of requesting permission to conduct an FBA and subsequent positive behavior support plan, the use of safe crisis management, and the use of school psychologist and counselors to assist in academic and social/emotional needs of students.

3. Describe the academic programming and training efforts the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in the general education curriculum.

Previous professional development included Up and Down Differentiation, Scaffolding and Data Guided Instruction for Struggling Students. As we proceed, Co-Teaching professional development will be provided for teachers and special education teachers who are working together with the general education and Special Education population. Strategies will be provided on how best to support the students, as well as, how to utilize both teachers in the classroom in an efficient and effective manner. Scaffolding is another professional development for all teaching staff to help them assist students in their learning and mastery of skills. Due to the inclusion of our more intensive population, scaffolding is necessary for the success of students. Also, Specialist teachers will receive specific PD, SpEd 101 and how to work with students with disabilities. Functional Behavior Analysis training will occur for all educational staff. School psychologists will offer the training to support teachers and paraprofessionals on how to track student data and to provide strategies to be utilized in the classroom for students exhibiting disruptive behaviors. Differentiated instruction training will be provided to all staff within the District, this training will assist teachers how to modify instruction and classwork for all students. Further training and the use of PATTAN's toolkit and their consultants professional development on supplementary aides and services will be provided to all staff. Training will be provided on Station Rotation with the expectation of implemented during the 2022-23 school year. It is a model in which small group instruction will occur during each subject area throughout the day.

- 4. Describe the supplementary aids and services the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in extracurricular activities. The District provides a continuum of services K-12. In previous years, the special education staff were specifically trained on the Supplementary Aids and Services Toolkit and how to use the placement questions in the IEP in order to optimize supports in the general education setting and curriculum. The District provides transportation for students to and from extracurricular practices and events. Paraprofessionals and other staff support students during meals, recess, and club periods. The district consults with the IU for vision supports. Adaptive physical education allows students with intensive physical disabilities to participate in appropriate physical activities. Other services may be provided on a 1:1 basis, per the needs of the student. Case managers and special education teachers work with coaches and advisors to implement positive behavior supports and accommodations that enable student participation in extra- curricular activities.
- 5. Describe the District procedures, which ensure that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities placed in private institutions are educated with non-disabled children and have the opportunity to participate in district lead extracurricular activities? All students attending private institutions are allowed to participate in District-wide activities. Transportation is provided by the District from the private institution to the district-site. District- wide announcements are included on the District website.
- 6. Discuss the district's need to build capacity and expand programs and services in an effort to provide a continuum of services. (Consider the out of district placement chart)

The Harrisburg School District continue to focus on recruitment and retention of highly qualified individuals. The District will continue to send personnel to job fairs in order to effectively recruit. A SpEd staff member has been added to the recruiting team to actively recruit Special Education highly qualified individuals. The District benefits from training, consultation, and technical assistance from state-wide intermediate units and PaTTAN. The District acknowledges the need to implement district-wide programs in order to expand equitable programming and services across the district. However, the needs of the students must be met which is the number one priority.

- 1. How does the district support the emotional, social needs of students with disabilities?
  - The School Board Policy 113.2 directs the district's behavior support programs be based on positive rather than negative behavior techniques to ensure that students shall be free from demeaning treatment and unreasonable use of restraints or other aversive techniques. The use of restraints shall be considered a measure of last resort and shall only be used after other less restrictive measures, including d-e-escalation techniques. Behavior support programs and plans shall be based on a functional behavior assessment and shall include a variety of research-based techniques to develop and maintain skills that will enhance students' opportunity for learning and self-fulfillment. The Harrisburg School District utilizes the Second Step curriculum daily which is a violence prevention/social skills curriculum that teaches skills to reduce impulsive and aggressive behavior in children and increase their level of social competence. The district employs four Licensed Social Workers who work individually and with small groups of students who require more intensive support. The district contracts with PA Counseling to provide therapeutic individual or small group therapy sessions to process their problems and learn productive coping strategies.
- 2. Describe training provided to staff in the use of positive behavior supports, de-escalation techniques and responses to behavior that may require immediate intervention.

During the 2021-2022 school year the Harrisburg School District established three Behavior Specialist positions who support students who exhibit interfering behavior and the staff who support these students. However, only one of the positions are filled at this time. The district has four staff members certified as Safe Crisis Management (SCM) trainers and provide initial and recertification training throughout the school year to staff as needed. A portion of the SCM training include de-escalation strategies. These trainings are provided to security guards, Autism and Emotional Support (teachers and paraprofessionals), physical education and health teachers and administrators. The District's K-12 intensive autistic support programs participate in the PDE Autism Initiative and receive consultation from PaTTAN consultants. Other trainings provided to staff include Second Step which is a research based social emotional curriculum that will be incorporated into daily morning meetings or advisory period; Functional Behavior Assessments a team process for identifying problem behaviors and developing interventions to replace or eliminate those behaviors; PBSP are developed for students who demonstrate behaviors that impede his/her learning and/or that of others. The plans include a detailed crisis plan in case of an emergency. PBSP are developed using the data from FBAs; and The Harrisburg School District administrators were also provided trainings as a result of SPP4, which included Responsive Practices, Child Find, MTSS and Suspension and Student with Disabilities w/Manifestation Determination. The district continues to offer opportunities for staff to attend sessions at CAIU, PaTTAN and PDE conferences. The district has also established a district processes to respond to behaviors that may require immediate interventions. School personnel are trained in positive behavior techniques including administrators, teachers, specialists, and support staff. Students with emotional, social, and behavioral needs are supported safety concerns are present, and the techniques are based in positive reinforcement and de-escalation techniques. Positive behavior support plans that are developed also teach replacement behaviors and the necessary skills to assist a student to achieve positive outcomes in certain situations.

3. Describe the district positive school wide support programs.

The Harrisburg School District began training for School Wide PBIS in 2011 and have implemented school-wide positive behavior supports in all schools. Every school has a list of rules and expectations developed with identified positive rewards for students who are following these expectations. Presently, there are have a number of buildings using the program and some with Fidelty. Scott Elementary School are using PBIS with fidelity. They have consistently had recognition at Tiers 1-2 for the last 6 years and Tier 3 recognition twice, and will have it again for next year. They presented at the PBIS Implementers Forum (a few years ago), SAS Conference(19-20), and the Check and Connect Conference at the University of Minnesota(21-22). Their Fidelity Checklist this year showed 100% at Tiers 1 and 2, and 84% at Tier 3. Foose Elementary School is PBIS Tier 1 recognized and has been as long as I've been at Foose. Students follow the 3Rs – ready, responsible, and respectful. They earn "punches" on a punch card. When they fill up the card, 30 punches, in one month, they earn a PAW Party to celebrate following the 3Rs. This month is a carnival. Next month is tie-dying T-Shirts. Students look forward to the monthly paw parties. Their PBIS tier 1 subcommittee looks at SWIS data monthly to target specific school wide behaviors and address them. Tier 1 goes over data with our staff at our monthly staff meetings. Our PBIS tier 2 subcommittee addresses individual concerns and we use the check in and check out system. We are hoping to go for our PBIS Tier 2 recognition next school year. From a district perspective, for the start of the 22-23 school year the administration will be providing district wide PBIS expectations and resources that is consistent in all schools.

4. Describe the district school-based behavior health services.

The Harrisburg School district employs four Licensed Social Workers who work individually and with small groups of students who require more intensive support. The district contracts with PA Counseling to provide therapeutic individual or small group therapy sessions to process their problems and learn productive coping strategies. The 21-22 School year the district also partnered with Effective School Solutions to implement culturally inclusive mental health and behavior support programs to maintain students in their home district. For the 22-23 school year the every building will have one or more LSW to provide the supports and services to students and plan to implement a Mental Health MTSS Playbook.

5. Describe the district restraint procedure.

Harrisburg School District Board Policy 113.2 (Behavior supports) directs the use of restraints only as a last resort and only after other less restrictive measures have been used. Restraints must be documented in all IEPs when the school-team and parents agree that restrains may be necessary, along with the type(s) that may be used. When restraints are used, the district must notify the parent that day, and then hold an IEP meeting within 10 days (unless the parent waives the need for a meeting). All written documentation and special education documents are sent to the special education department for filing and documentation in the Department of Education website.

#### Intensive Interagency

At this time the Harrisburg School District does not have any students who are placed Instruction conducted in the Home or students who are at a substantial risk of waiting more than 30 days for an educational placement. The district always attempts to place students within their own district and utilize any supplementary aids and modifications to allow for student success in the regular school environment. When the district exhaust all possibilities in the regular school setting, the student is not achieving, the interagency approach or CAIU 15 will be utilized for services. LEAs must also report students with disabilities who are placed on instruction conducted in the home or who receive homebound instruction in accordance with BEC 34 CFR §300.26(a)(1), Instruction Conducted in the Home, in the Special Education Students @ Home Reporting System, so that the Department can determine whether these students require intensive interagency coordination.
