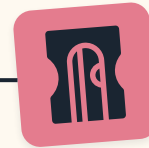
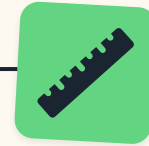

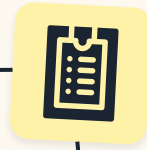

Vanden Graduation Requirements



Total Credits	220 (5/semester)
English	40 credits
Physical Education	20 credits
Health	5 credits
Math--(to include 1 year of Alg.)	20 credits
Science	20 credits
World History	10 credits
US History	10 credits
Government	10 credits
Economics	5 credits
Foreign Lang OR Fine Art OR CTE	10 Credits
Electives	70 credits

- Students earn 5 credits per class, per semester
- Students earn a grade/credit EACH semester
 - Semester grades are not averaged to one total grade





- Students must earn a D- or better to earn credit for the class



A-G Requirements

- Academic Requirements for CSU's and UC's
 - Most other 4 years in state and out of state have very similar requirements
- Grade of a C or better is required



A	2 years	Social Science -including 1 year of US History or ½ year of civics or American Government and 1 year of World History, Cultures, and/or Geography
B	4 years	English -Composition and Literature, and other designated college preparatory courses
C	3 years	Mathematics -Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2; or higher level math course, i.e. Trigonometry, Calculus, Statistics & Probability
D	2 years	Laboratory Science -Biology, Chemistry, Physics, etc. One biological science and one physical science
E	2 years	Language other than English -in the same language
F	1 year	Visual and Performing Arts -art, dance, theatre/drama, or music
G	1 year	College Preparatory Elective -chosen from the subject areas listed above

➤ What is NCAA?



National Collegiate Athletic Association

- NCAA is an organization dedicated to providing a pathway to opportunity for college athletes and high school student athletes that wish to continue to compete in their sport after high school

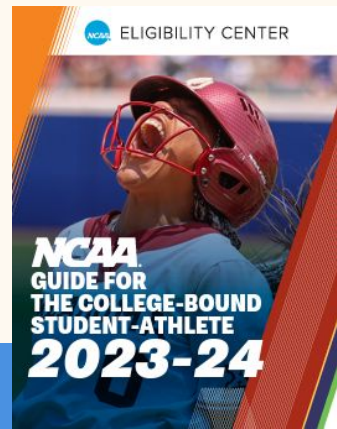


NCAA Division Requirements

- Division 1 and 2: students must complete 16 core courses to be eligible for NCAA, must maintain certain GPA
 - Division 1 requires 10 out of 16 courses completed before the start of the students 7th semester

9th-11th Grade Checklist

- Courses: Be enrolled in NCAA- approved courses each year and earn a GPA of at least a 2.2 or more



ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

To study and compete at a Division I or II school, you must earn 16 NCAA-approved **core-course credits**, earn a minimum 2.3 (Division I) or 2.2 (Division II) **core-course GPA** and submit your final transcript with proof of graduation to the Eligibility Center.

CORE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS

DIVISION I

Earn 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits in the following areas:



For Division I, 10 of your 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits must be completed before the start of your seventh semester, including seven in English, math or science.

DIVISION II

Earn 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits in the following areas:





GRADE-POINT AVERAGE

The Eligibility Center calculates your **core-course GPA** based on the grades you earn in NCAA-approved core courses.

- » Division I requires a minimum 2.3 core-course GPA.
- » Division II requires a minimum 2.2 core-course GPA.



TEST SCORES

In January 2023, NCAA **Divisions I and II** adopted legislation to remove standardized test scores from initial-eligibility requirements. Check with the NCAA school you plan to attend regarding whether standardized test scores are necessary for admission or scholarship requirements.

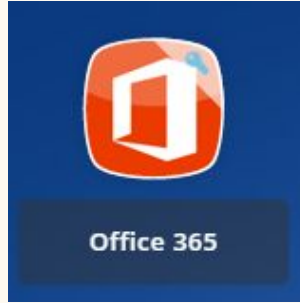

➤ How CalKIDS Works

Kids in grades 1-12 may receive up to \$1,500 in college savings

The State of California will offer eligible low-income public school students the following awards in a CalKIDS account to save for higher education, as applicable:*

- \$500 automatic deposit for eligible low-income public school students enrolled in 1st-12th grade
- \$500 additional deposit for eligible students identified as foster youth
- \$500 additional deposit for eligible students experiencing homelessness

Overtime, funds in a CalKIDS account can grow tax-free and be used for higher education expenses, such as tuition, books, computers, and room and board. When the student is ready to use their savings to pay for any qualified higher education expense, they can easily redeem their funds, including any earnings, from their CalKIDS account.
